

NOTES

SEWER:

1. Remove existing M.H. No. 604 and build a 4' dia. type "E" drop manhole

WATER:

1. Lay approx. 297 L.F. of 6" C.I.P. one foot north (parallel) of existing 4" steel water line as shown.

2. Tie into existing 6" C.I. (sta. 9+89), and 6" gate valve (sta. 12+76) with all fittings as needed to be field verified.
3. Transfer all water service lines at the time of main connections to minimize water service disruption.

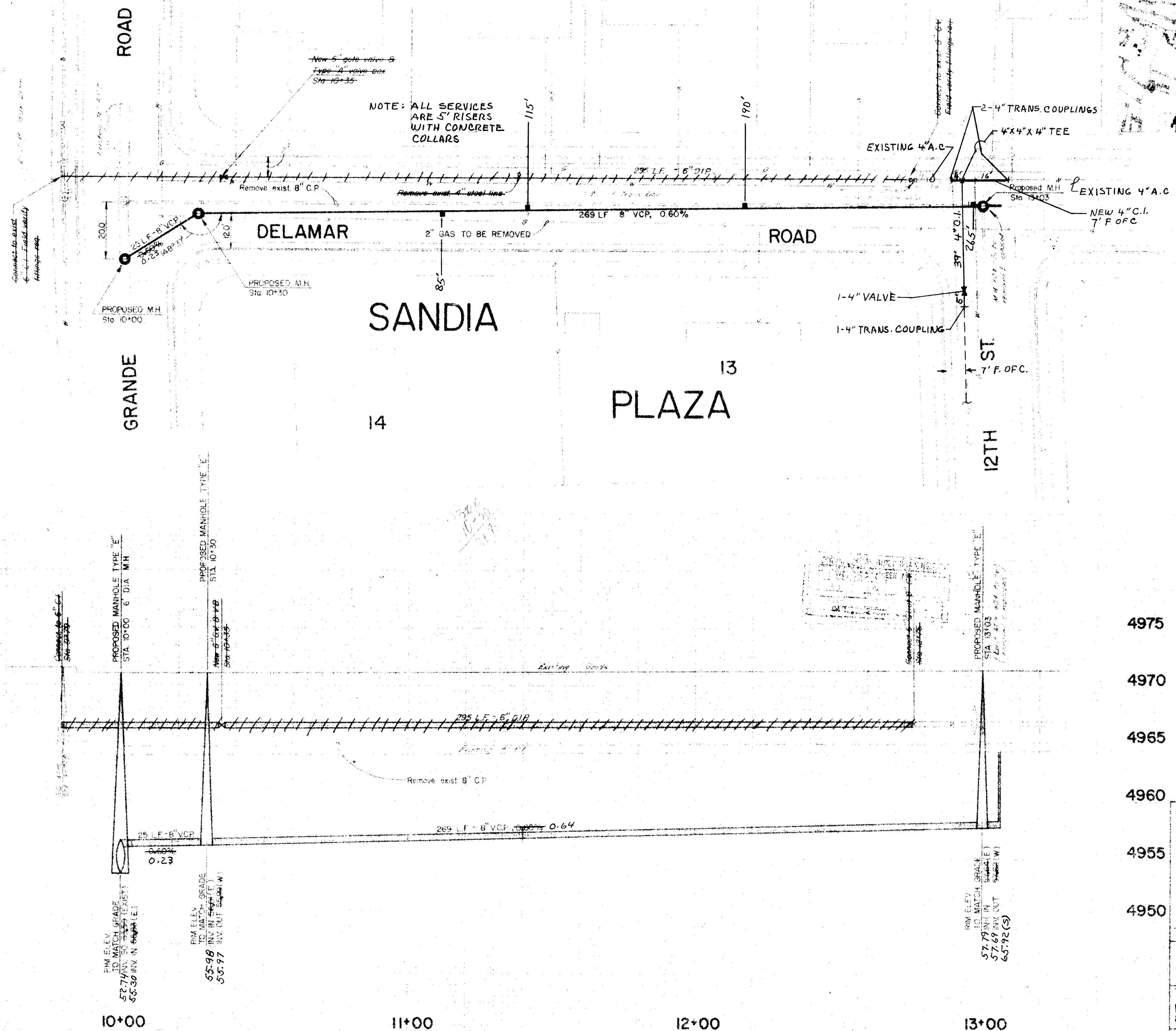

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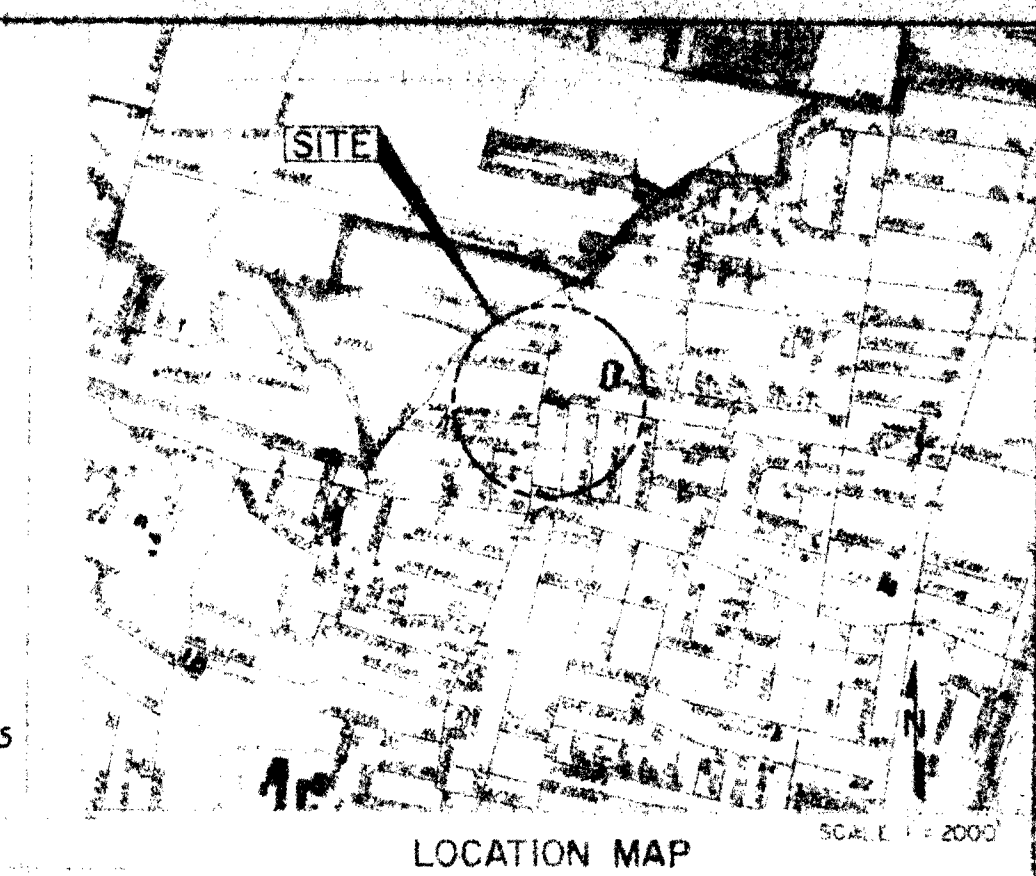

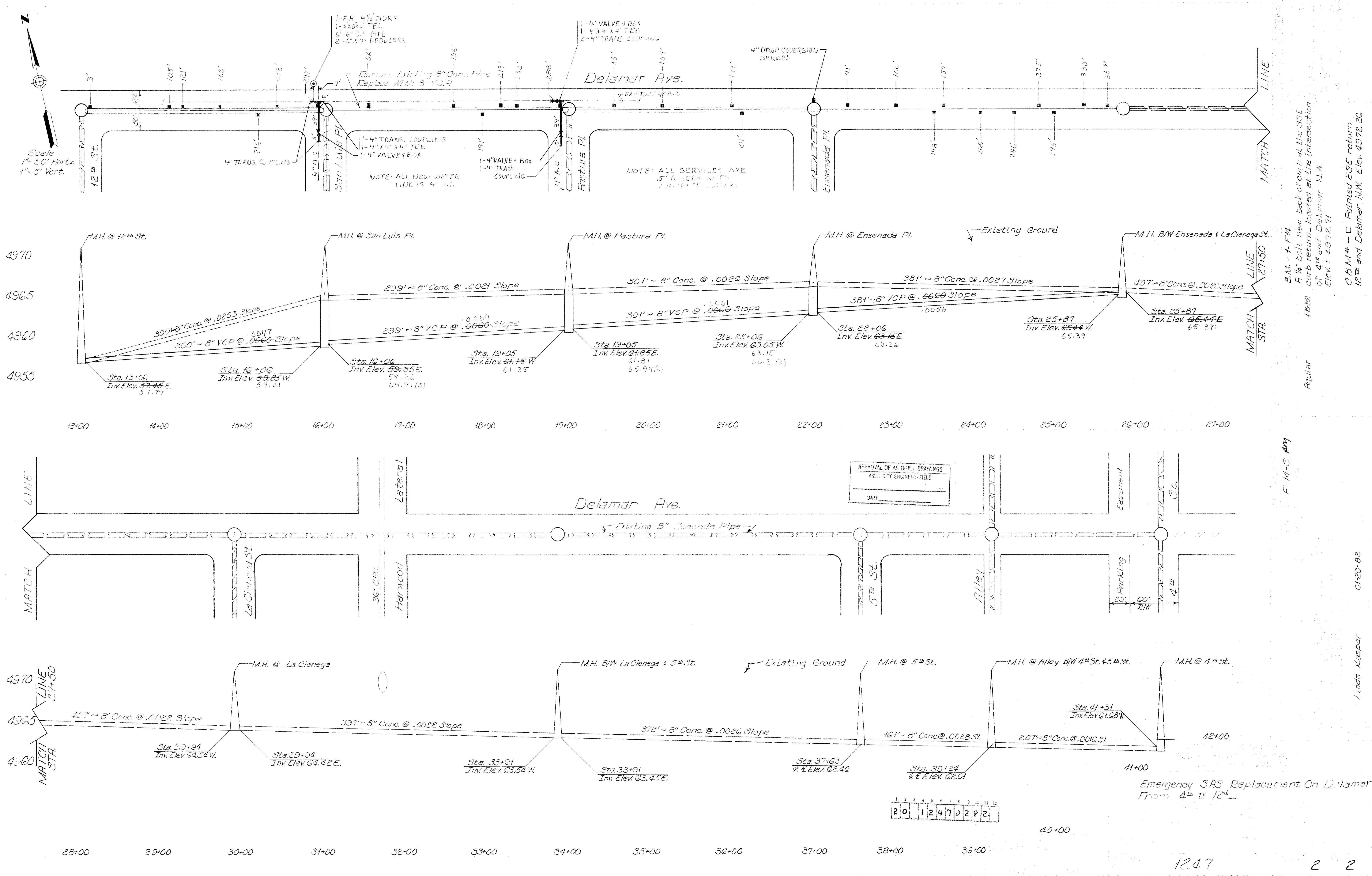
