GENERAL NOTES

- 1. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER CONTRACT SHALL, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED FOR HEREON, BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS--PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION--1986.
- 2. ALL WORK ON THIS PROJECT SHALL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION SAFETY AND HEALTH.
- 3. UTILITIES LOCATIONS AS SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS ARE APPROXIMATE. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE EXACT LOCATION OF LINES AND UTILITY CONNECTION POINTS IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF THE PROPOSED SITE MAY BE SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT FROM THE LOCATION SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY.
- 4. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST BETWEEN THESE PLANS AND ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE ENGINEER IN WRITING SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY FOR ALL PARTIES.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- 6. THREE (3) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CONSTRUCTION COORDIN-ATION DIVISION A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A BARRICADING PERMIT FROM THE CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION DIVISION. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE BARRICADE ENGINEER (768-2551) PRIOR TO OCCUPYING AN INTER-SECTION, SEE SECTION 19 OF THE SPECIFICATIONS.

ALL STREET STRIPING ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO THE EXISTING PATTERNS OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.

- 7. Drivepad grades shall be constructed in accordance with STD. DRWG. No. 2425. CONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM MINOR GRADING, INCLUDING MINOR FILLING, TO TRANSITION FROM ENDS OF NEW DRIVEPADS TO EXISTING GRADES WHICH WORK SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE DRIVEPAD PAY ITEM. CONTRACTOR SHALL SECURE PERMISSION FOR GRADING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.
- 8. WHEELCHAIR RAMPS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STD. DRWG. No. 2441 EXISTING CURB FACES SHALL BE SAWCUT TO WHEELCHAIR PROFILE GRADES. WHERE EXISTING STORM DRAINAGE INLETS OCCUR AT CURB RETURNS, THEY SHALL BE MODIFIED TO ACCOMMODATE THE NEW WHEELCHAIR RAMPS PER DETAILS SHOWN ON THESE PLANS.
- 9. "CURB TYPE SIDEWALKS" REFER TO STANDARD SIDEWALKS PLACED AT THE BACK OF CURB. "OFFSET TYPE SIDEWALKS" REFER TO STANDARD SIDEWALKS OFFSET FROM BACK OF CURB.
- 10. "SIDEWALK" PAY ITEM SHALL INCLUDE CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION AT WHEELCHAIR RAMPS INCLUDING THICKENED EDGE OR HEADER CURB FOR CASE I RAMPS.
- 11. REQUIRED CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE:
 - PHASE I SOUTH SIDE OF MOUNTAIN ROAD BEGINNING AT WEST END AND PROGRESSING TO EAST END
 - PHASE II NORTH SIDE OF MOUNTAIN ROAD BEGINNING AT WEST END AND PROGRESSING TO EAST END
 - NOTE: Phase I must be completed before starting Phase II








