


THE CONNOLLY RESIDENCE

7941 WOODRIDGE NE LOT # 11 COUNTRYWOOD ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO

GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER CONTRACT SHALL, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED FOR HERON, BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE "CITY OF ALBU-QUERQUE, STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, 1986" (COA STND).
- TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION, CONTRACTOR
 MUST CONTACT NEW MEXICO ONE CALL SYSTEM, 260-1990, FOR LOCA TION OF EXISTING UTILITIES.
- 3. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL OBSTRUCTIONS. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER OR SURVEYOR SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY.
- 4. IF ANY UTILITY LINES, PIPELINES, OR UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES ARE SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS, THEY ARE SHOWN IN AN APPROXI-MATE MANNER ONLY, AND SUCH LINES MAY EXIST WHERE NONE ARE SHOWN. IF ANY SUCH EXISTING LINES ARE SHOWN, THE LOCATION IS BASED UPON INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE OWNER OF SAID UTILI-TY. AND THE INFORMATION MAY BE INCOMPLETE, OR MAY BE OBSO-LETE BY THE TIME CONSTRUCTION COMMENCES. THE ENGINEER HAS UNDERTAKEN NO FIELD VERIFICATION OF THE LOCATION, DEPTH, SIZE, OR TYPE OF EXISTING UTILITY LINES, PIPELINES, OR UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INFORM HIMSELF OF THE LOCATION OF ANY UTILITY LINE, PIPELINE, OR UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINE IN OR NEAR THE AREA OF THE WORK IN ADVANCE OF AND DUR-ING EXCAVATION WORK. THE CONTRACTOR IS FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGE CAUSED BY HIS FAILURE TO LOCATE, IDENTIFY AND PRESERVE ANY AND ALL EXISTING UTILITIES, PIPELINES, AND UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES. IN PLANNING AND CONDUCTING EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH STATE STAT-UTES, MUNICIPAL AND LOCAL ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, IF ANY, PERTAINING TO THE LOCATION OF THESE LINES AND FACILI-TIES.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROMPTLY CLEAN UP ANY MATERIAL EXCA-VATED WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY SO THAT THE EXCAVATED MATERIAL IS NOT SUSCEPTIBLE TO BEING WASHED DOWN THE STREET
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSIST THE ENGINEER/INSPECTOR IN THE RECORDING OF DATA ON ALL UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES AS REQUIRED BY THE OWNERS FOR THE PREPARATION OF "RECORD DRAWINGS". THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT COVER UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES UNTIL ALL DATA HAS BEEN RECORDED.
- 7. REFERENCE MADE TO STANDARD DRAWINGS REFER TO ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD DRAWINGS.
- 8. CURB AND GUTTER SHOWN AS EXISTING AND NOT TO BE REMOVED UNDER THE CONTRACT WHICH IS DAMAGED OR DISPLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT HIS EXPENSE.
- WHEN CONSTRUCTION UNDER THIS PROJECT CONNECTS TO EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AN EASY RIDING CONNECTION.
- 10. ALL WORK ON THIS PROJECT SHALL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION SAFETY AND HEALTH.
- 11. ALL FITTINGS ON WATERLINES SHALL HAVE RESTRAINED JOINTS TO DEVELOPMENT LENGTH OF WATERLINE DURING TESTING.
- 12. ELECTRONIC MARKER DISCS SHALL BE PLACED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 170 OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE, STANDARD SPECIFICA—TIONS, PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION.
- 13. WATERLINE 12" IN DIAMETER AND SMALLER MAY BE DUCTILE IRON OR PVC, C-900.
- WATERLINES SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM COVER OF 3'6" UNLESS OTHER— WISE NOTED.
- 15. FIRE HYDRANTS SHALL BE INSTALLED AND/OR RELOCATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY STD.DWG. 2340.
- 16. ALL CONSTRUCTION WITHIN CITY RIGHT—OF—WAY OR EASEMENTS MUST BE DONE FROM APPROVED WORK ORDER DOCUMENTS FROM THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE AND PREPARED BY MCDOWELL ENGINEERING, INC.
- 17. AN EXCAVATION/CONSTRUCTION PERMIT WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK WITHIN CITY RIGHT—OF—WAY. AN APPROVED COPY OF THESE PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF APPLICA—TION FOR THIS PERMIT.
- 18. BACKFILL COMPACTION SHALL BE ACCORDING TO ARTERIAL STREET USE.
- 19. MAINTENANCE OF THESE FACILITIES SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY SERVED.
- 20. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING A PERMIT TO CON-STRUCT FACILITIES WITHIN CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.
- 21. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE 12" SUBGRADE PREPARATION UNDER ALL NEW PAVEMENT, CURBS AND GUTTERS, VALLEY GUTTERS AND CONCRETE FILLETS.
- 22. WHEN ABUTTING NEW PAVEMENT TO EXISTING, CUT BACK EXISTING PAVEMENT TO A NEAT, STRAIGHT LINE AS REQUIRED TO REMOVE ANY BROKEN OR CRACKED PAVEMENT, AND MATCH NEW TO EXISTING.
- 23. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE ANY WATER VALVE SHUT-OFF OPERATION WITH THE CITY WATER SYSTEMS DIVISION (857-8200) NOT LESS THAN THREE (3) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO INITIATING ANY WORK AFFECTING EXISTING WATER UTILITIES. SEE SECTION 18 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS.
- 24. TRAFFIC CONTROL:
 THREE (3) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CONSTRUCTION CO—ORDINATION DIVISION A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A BARRICADING PERMIT FROM THE CONSTRUCTION CO—ORDINATION DIVISION. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY BARRICADE ENGINEER (768—2251) PRIOR TO OCCUPYING AN INTERSECTION. SEE SECTION 19 OF THE SPECIFICATIONS. ALL STREET STRIPING ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED IN KIND BY CONTRACTOR TO LOCATION AND IN KIND AS EXISTING OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.
