

GENERAL NOTES

- All work detailed on these plans to be performed under contract shall, except as otherwise stated or provided for hereon, be constructed in accordance with the City of Albuquerque Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction 1986 Edition with update No.4 (referred to herein as the Standard Specifications)
- 2. Two (2) working days prior to any excavation, contractor must contact Line Locating Service, 260-1990, for location of existing utilities.
- 3. Prior to construction, the contractor shall excavate and verify the horizontal and vertical locations of all obstructions. Should a conflict exist, the contractor shall notify the engineer or surveyor so that the conflict can be resolved with minimum amount of delay.
- 4. All grading shall conform to the recommendation in the soils report prepared by Vinyard Assoc. dated 9/16/93, Proj. No.93—1—159
 Pavement materials recommendations in said soils report.
- 5. When referenced on the drawings the contractor shall submit shop drawings to the engineer for his review and approval. Drawings shall show sufficient details showing material to be used, dirnensions and other pertinent data so the engineer may determine the adequacy of the item.
- 6. Items such as masonry walls which require calculations to determine bar sizes and spacing, shall also be submitted for the engineer's review. All calculations shall be prepared by a licensed structural engineer.
- 7. Three (3) working days prior to beginning construction, the contractor shall submit a detailed construction schedule.

 Two (2) working days prior to construction, the contractor shall obtain a barricade permit from the Construction Coordination Division. Contractor shall notify Barricade Engineer (768—2551) prior to occupying an intersection. Refer to Section 19 of the general conditions of the Standard Specifications.
- 8. All street striping altered or destroyed shall be replaced in kind by contractor to location and in kind as existing or as indicated by this plan set.
- 9. Contractor shall notify the engineer not less than seven (7) days prior to starting work in order that the engineer may take necessary measures to insure the preservation of survey monuments, Contractor shall not disturb permanent survey monuments without the consent of the engineer and shall notify the engineer and bear the expense of replacing any that may be disturbed without permission. Replacement shall be done only by the city surveyor. When a change is made in the finished elevations of the pavement of any roadway in which a permanent survey monument is located. Contractor shall, at his own expense, adjust the monument cover to the new grade unless otherwise specified. Refer to Section 4.4 of the general conditions of the Standard Specifications.




