





WATER VALVE SHUTOFF PLAN NOTES:

- 1. AS A MINIMUM, THE FOLLOWING VALVES SHALL BE CLOSED TO FACILITATE THE NON-PRESSURE CONNECTION:
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY WATER SYSTEMS THREE (3) WORKING DAYS IN ADVANCE OF ANY WORK THAT MAY AFFECT EXISTING WATERLINE. ALL SHUTOFFS SHALL BE PERFORMED BY THE WATER SYSTEM DIVISION PERSONNEL (857–8200)
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE ALL RESTRAINTS AND THRUST BLOCKS NECESSARY TO EFFECT THE NECESSARY SHUTOFFS AND CONNECTIONS.
- 4. EXISTING WATER VALVE AND WATERLINE INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE AUTOMATED WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM SECTIONAL MAPS, PLATE K-16.


SIDEWALK REMOVALS AND REPLACEMENT BY SEPARATE PERMIT.


GENERAL NOTES:


- 1. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER CONTRACT SHALL, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED FOR HEREON, BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION 1986. (UPDATE NO.5)
- 2. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION, CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT NEW MEXICO ONE CALL SYSTEM, 260-1990, FOR LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES.
- 3. IF ANY UTILITY LINES, PIPELINES, OR UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES ARE SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS, THEY ARE SHOWN IN AN APPROXIMATE MANNER ONLY, AND SUCH LINES MAY EXIST WHERE NONE ARE SHOWN. IF ANY SUCH EXISTING LINES ARE SHOWN, THE LOCATION IS BASED UPON INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE OWNER OF SAID UTILITY, AND THE INFORMATION MAY BE INCOMPLETE, OR MAY BE OBSOLETE BY THE TIME CONSTRUCTION COMMENCES. THE ENGINEER HAS CONDUCTED ONLY PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION OF THE LOCATION, DEPTH, SIZE, OR TYPE OF EXISTING UTILITY LINES, PIPELINES, OR UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES. THIS INVESTIGATION IS NOT CONCLUSIVE, AND MAY NOT BE COMPLETE, THEREFORE, MAKES NO REPRESENTATION PERTAINING THERETO, AND ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY THEREFOR. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INFORM ITSELF OF THE LOCATION OF ANY UTILITY LINE, PIPELINE, OR UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINE IN OR NEAR THE AREA OF THE WORK IN ADVANCE OF AND DURING EXCAVATION WORK. THE CONTRACTOR IS FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND AND AND AND AND DURING EXCAVATION WORK. THE CONTRACTOR IS FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND AND AND AND DEPTH INTO THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH STATE STATUTES, MUNICIPAL AND LOCAL ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, IF ANY, PERTAINING TO THE LOCATION OF THESE LINES AND FACILITIES.
- 4. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST BETWEEN THESE PLANS AND ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE ENGINEER IN WRITING SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY FOR ALL PARTIES.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- 6. ALL WORK ON THIS PROJECT SHALL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING SAFETY AND HEALTH.
- 7. ALL UTILITIES AND UTILITY SERVICE LINES SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO PAVING.
- 8. BACKFILL COMPACTION SHALL BE ACCORDING TO SPECIFIED STREET USE.
- 9. TACK COAT REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE DETERMINED DURING CONSTRUCTION BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER.
- 10. SIDEWALKS AND WHEELCHAIR RAMPS WITHIN THE CURB RETURNS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WHEREVER A NEW CURB RETURN IS CONSTRUCTED.
- 11. IF CURB IS DEPRESSED FOR A DRIVEPAD OR A HANDICAP RAMP, THE DRIVEPAD OR RAMP SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE OF THE CURB AND GUTTER.
- 12. ALL STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES SHALL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO FINAL ACCEPTANCE.
- 13. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE WATER SYSTEM DIVISION FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE VALVE SHUT OFF PLAN, NOT LESS THAN THREE (3) WORKING DAYS IN ADVANCE OF ANY WORK THAT MAY AFFECT THE EXISTING PUBLIC WATER UTILITIES. ONLY WATER SYSTEM DIVISION PERSONNEL SHALL OPERATE EXISTING VALVES. REFER TO SECTION 18 OF THE SPECIFICATION.
- 14. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR NOT LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO STARTING WORK IN ORDER THAT THE CITY SURVEYOR MAY TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES TO INSURE THE PRESERVATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT DISTURB PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENTS WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE CITY SURVEYOR AND SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR AND BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE DISTURBED WITHOUT PERMISSION. REPLACEMENT SHALL BE DONE ONLY BY THE CITY SURVEYOR. WHEN A CHANGE IS MADE IN THE FINISHED ELEVATION OF THE PAVEMENT OF ANY ROADWAY IN WHICH A PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENT IS LOCATED, CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE, ADJUST THE MONUMENT COVER TO THE NEW GRADE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED. REFER TO SECTION 4.4 OF THE SPECIFICATIONS.
- 15. THREE (3) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CONSTRUCTION CO-ORDINATION DIVISION A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A BARRICADING PERMIT FROM THE CONSTRUCTION CO-ORDINATION DIVISION. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY BARRICADE ENGINEER (768-2551) PRIOR TO OCCUPYING AN INTERSECTION, CONTRACTOR MUST REFER TO SECTION 19 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATION FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL.
- 16. ALL STREET STRIPING ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED IN KIND BY CONTRACTOR TO LOCATION AND IN KIND AS EXISTING OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.
- 17. CAUTION: THESE DRAWINGS DO NOT INCLUDE NECESSARY COMPONENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION SAFETY WHICH SHALL REMAIN THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR.
- 18. ANY WORK OCCURING WITHIN AN ARTERIAL ROADWAY REQUIRES TWENTY-FOUR HOUR CONSTRUCTION.
- 19. ALL UTILITIES ENCOUNTERED WITHIN THE WORK AREA SHALL BE ADJUSTED TO GRADE. ALL COSTS INCURRED IN MAKING THE ADJUSTMENTS SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO CONSTRUCTION, THEREFORE, NO SEPARATE PAYMENT WILL BE MADE.
