

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH STATE STATUTES, MUNICIPAL AND LOCAL ORDINANCES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE LOCATION OF THESE LINES AND FACILITIES IN PLANNING AND CONDUCTING EXCAVATION, WHETHER BY CALLING OR NOTIFY—ING THE UTILITIES, COMPLYING WITH "BLUE STAKES" PROCEDURES, OR OTHERWISE.



GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER CONTRACT SHALL EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED FOR HEREON, BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, 1986 EDITION (UPDATE #6).
- TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION, CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT "NEW MEXICO ONE CALLS SYSTEM" (260— 1990) FOR LOCATION OF UTILITIES.
- 3. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORI—ZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL OBSTRUCTIONS. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER OR SURVEYOR SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY.
- 4. ALL UTILITIES AND UTILITY SERVICE LINES SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO PAVING.
- 5. CONTACT WATER SYSTEMS DIVISION (857-8207) 5 WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO NEEDING VALVES SHUT OFF OR TURNED ON. ONLY WATER SYSTEM PERSONNEL ARE TO OPERATE VALVES.
- 6. THREE (3) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACT—OR SHALL SUBMIT TO CONSTRUCTION CO—ORDINATION DIVISION A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCT—ION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A BARRICADING PERMIT FROM THE CON—STRUCTION CO—ORDINATION DIVISION. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY BARRICADE ENGINEER (768—2551) PRIOR TO OCCUPYING AN INTERSECTION. REFER TO SECTION 19 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 7. ALL STREET STRIPING ALTERED OR DES-TROYED SHALL BE REPLACED WITH PLASTIC REFLECTORIZED PAVEMENT MARKINGS BY CONTRACTOR TO LOCATION AS EXISTING OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.
- 8. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER NOT LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO STARTING WORK IN ORDER THAT THE EN-GINEER MAY TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES TO INSURE THE PRESERVATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT DISTURB PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENTS WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE ENGINEER AND SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER AND BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE DISTURBED WITHOUT PER-MISSION. REPLACEMENT SHALL BE DONE ONLY BY THE CITY SURVEYOR. WHEN A CHANGE IS MADE IN THE FINISHED ELE-VATIONS OF THE PAVEMENT OF ANY ROAD-WAY IN WHICH A PERMANENT SURVEY MON-UMENT IS LOCATED, CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE, ADJUST THE MONU-MENT COVER TO THE NEW GRADE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED. REFER TO SECTION 4.4 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
