



CERTIFICATE OF SUBSTANTIAL COMPLIANCE ON PLANS

I, Matthew A. Santistevan of the firm of Bohannan Huston, Inc., a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of New Mexico, do hereby certify, to the best of my knowledge and belief, that the infrastructure installed as shown on these drawings (12" Waterline Extension in I-25 at North Camino Arroyo, City Project No. 759291) has been inspected by me or by a qualified person under my direct supervision and has been constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications and that the original design intent of the approved plans has been met, except as noted by me on the as-built construction drawings. This Certification is based on site inspections by me or personnel under my direction and survey information provided by the contractor, A.S. Horner, Inc. and their surveyor.





CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ABIDE BY ALL LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH APPLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS.

2. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL POTENTIAL OBSTRUCTIONS. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER OR CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY.

3. ALL ELECTRICAL, TELEPHONE, CABLE TV, GAS AND OTHER UTILITY LINES, CABLES AND APPURTENANCES ENCOUNTERED DURING CONSTRUCTION THAT REQUIRE RELOCATION, SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THAT UTILITY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATION OF ALL NECESSARY UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS. NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION WILL BE ALLOWED FOR DELAYS OR INCONVENIENCES CAUSED BY UTILITY COMPANY WORK CREWS. THE CONTRACTOR MAY BE REQUIRED TO RESCHEDULE HIS ACTIVITIES TO ALLOW UTILITY CREWS TO PERFORM THEIR REQUIRED WORK.

4. DISPOSAL SITE FOR ALL EXCESS EXCAVATION MATERIAL, AND UNSUITABLE MATERIAL SHALL BE OBTAINED BY THE CONTRACTOR IN COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS AND APPROVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER. ALL COSTS INCURRED IN OBTAINING A DISPOSAL SITE AND HAUL THERETO SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO THE PROJECT AND NO SEPARATE MEASUREMENT OR PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE.

5. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING THE EXISTING UTILITY LINES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREA. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING FACILITIES CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE AND APPROVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION

6. CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE PROPERTY AND/OR PROJECT LIMITS. ANY DAMAGE TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES RESULTING FROM THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. ANY COSTS INCURRED FOR REPAIRS SHALL BE THE COST OF THE CONTRACTOR.

7. OVERNIGHT PARKING OF CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT OBSTRUCT DRIVEWAYS OR DESIGNATED TRAFFIC LANES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT STORE ANY EQUIPMENT OR MATERIAL WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ALL THE NECESSARY PERMITS FOR THE PROJECT PRIOR TO COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION (I.E. BARRICADING, SURFACE

9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO REPLACE AT HIS EXPENSE ANY AND ALL PROPERTY CORNERS DESTROYED DURING CONSTRUCTION. ALL PROPERTY CORNERS MUST BE RESET BY A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR.

10. ALL BARRICADES AND CONSTRUCTION SIGNING SHALL CONFORM TO APPLICABLE SECTIONS OF THE "MANUAL OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" (MUTCD), U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, LATEST EDITION.

11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES AND SIGNING AT ALL TIMES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE PROPER LOCATION OF ALL BARRICADING AT THE END AND BEGINNING OF EACH DAY.

12. ALL SAWCUT PAVEMENT SHALL HAVE A UNIFORM EDGE AND BE SPRAYED WITH TACK.

13. WHEN ABUTTING NEW CURB AND GUTTER TO EXISTING PAVEMENT, A 1' WIDE SECTION OF EXISTING PAVEMENT ADJACENT TO THE CURB AND GUTTER SHALL BE SAWCUT, REMOVED, AND REPLACED AS PER THE STANDARD


14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENTS, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, CURB & GUTTER, DRIVE PADS, WHEELCHAIR RAMPS, AND SIDEWALK DURING CONSTRUCTION, APART FROM THOSE SECTIONS INDICATED FOR REMOVAL ON THE PLANS AND SHALL REPAIR OR REPLACE PER COA STANDARDS, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE.

15. ALL EXCAVATION, TRENCHING, AND SHORING ACTIVITIES MUST BE CARRIED-OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH OSHA 29 CFR 1926.650 SUBPART P.



- 3. TWO WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT NEW MEXICO
- SECTION 19 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS
- ALL WORK AFFECTING ARTERIAL ROADWAYS REQUIRES TWENTY—FOUR HOUR CONSTRUCTION.
- 7. ALL STREET STRIPING ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED W/ PLASTIC REFLECTORIZED
- WHICH A PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENT IS LOCATED. CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE, ADJUST THE MONUMENT COVER TO THE NEW GRADE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED REFER TO SECTION 4.4 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 9. CONTRACTOR SHALL RECORD DATA ON ALL UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES AS REQUIRED BY THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE FOR THE PREPARATION OF "AS CONSTRUCTED" DRAWINGS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT COVER UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES UNTIL ALL DATA HAS BEEN
- 10. CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A GRAFFITI-FREE WORK SITE. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROMPTLY REMOVE ANY GRAFFITI FROM ALL EQUIPMENT, WHETHER PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY.
- 1. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE WATER SYSTEMS DIVISION (857-8200) FIVE WORKING DAYS IN ADVANCE OF ANY WORK THAT MAY AFFECT EXISTING PUBLIC WATER OR SEWER UTILITIES. EXISTING VALVES TO BE OPERATED BY CITY PERSONNEL ONLY. CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE WATER SYSTEMS DIVISION THREE (3) DAYS PRIOR TO NEEDING VALVES TURNED ON OR OFF.

THE FOLLOWING NOTES ALSO APPLY WHEN CHECKED

- ALL UTILITIES AND UTILITY SERVICE LINES SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO PAVING.
- BACKFILL COMPACTION SHALL BE ACCORDING TO SPECIFIED STREET USE.
- TACK COAT REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE CITY ENGINEER.
- SIDEWALKS AND WHEELCHAIR RAMPS WITHIN THE CURB RETURNS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WHEREVER A NEW CURB RETURN IS CONSTRUCTED.
- IF CURBUS DEPRESSED FOR A DRIVEPAD, THE DRIVEPAD SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE OF CURB AND GUTTER.
- ALL STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES SHALL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO FINAL ACCEPTANCE.
- THE REQUESTOR OR DEVELOPER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF ALI
