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GENERAL NOTES

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ABIDE BY ALL LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH APPLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS.
2. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PERFORMED, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED HEREON, SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, 1986 EDITION, THROUGH UPDATE #9, AND WILL BE REFERRED TO HEREIN AS "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS". ADDITIONALLY, NMDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION, 2014 EDITION SHALL BE USED.
3. ALL CONSTRUCTION WITHIN CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY OR EASEMENTS MUST BE DONE FROM APPROVED WORK ORDER DOCUMENTS FROM THE CITY.
4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME THE SOLE AND COMPLETE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE JOB SITE CONDITIONS DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT, INCLUDING SAFETY OF ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTY. THIS REQUIREMENT SHALL APPLY CONTINUOUSLY AND NOT BE LIMITED TO NORMAL WORKING HOURS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS THE OWNER AND ENGINEER FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, REAL OR ALLEGED, IN CONNECTION WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK ON THIS PROJECT, EXCEPT LIABILITY ARISING FROM THE SOLE NEGLIGENCE OF THE OWNER OR ENGINEER
5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ALL NECESSARY PERMITS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR NOT LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO STARTING WORK IN ORDER THAT THE CITY SURVEYOR MAY TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES TO ENSURE THE PRESERVATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT DISTURB PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENTS WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE CITY SURVEYOR AND SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR AND BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE DISTURBED WITHOUT PERMISSION. ONLY THE CITY SURVEYOR SHALL REPLACE SURVEY MONUMENTS. WHEN A CHANGE IS MADE IN THE FINISHED ELEVATIONS OF THE PAVEMENT OF ANY ROADWAY IN WHICH A PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENT IS LOCATED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE, ADJUST THE MONUMENT COVER TO THE NEW GRADE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
7. ALL STREET STRIPING, ALTERED OR DESTROYED, SHALL BE THERMOPLASTIC REFLECTORIZED PAVEMENT MARKINGS TO SAME LOCATION AS EXISTING, OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.
8. SEVEN (7) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT TO DMD, CONSTRUCTION SERVICES DIVISION, A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN EXCAVATION AND BARRICADE PERMIT TWO (2) DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
9. NO PAVING ACTIVITIES SHALL BE STARTED UNTIL THE LOCATION AND SERVICEABILITY OF ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES WITHIN THE ROADWAY ARE APPROVED BY THE UTILITY OWNER AND THE CITY.
10. PNM WILL PROVIDE AT NO COST TO THE CITY OR THE CONTRACTOR THE REQUIRED PERSONNEL FOR INSPECTION OR OBSERVATION DEEMED NECESSARY BY PNM WHILE THE CONTRACTOR IS EXPOSING PNM’S CABLES. THE CONTRACTOR IS FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGE CAUSED BY ITS FAILURE TO LOCATE, IDENTIFY, AND PRESERVE ANY AND ALL EXISTING UTILITIES. ANY PREVIOUSLY UNKNOWN UTILITY RELOCATIONS IDENTIFIED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND APPROVED BY THE CITY PROJECT MANAGER SHALL BE COVERED THROUGH THE UTILITY RELOCATION ALLOWANCE ESTABLISHED FOR THIS PROJECT.
12. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO SUPPORT AND MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY OF ALL UNDERGROUND WATER, WASTEWATER, REUSE WATER, TELEPHONE, ELECTRIC CABLES AND CABLE TELEVISION UTILITIES AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER. CABLE IS TO BE SUPPORTED AT A MAXIMUM OF EVERY FIFTEEN (15) FEET. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH AND MAKE NECESSARY PAYMENT (IF ANY) TO UTILITY OWNER FOR DE-ENERGIZATION OF CABLES OR SUPPORT OF CABLES BY THE UTILITY OWNER.
13. CONTRACTOR, AT HIS EXPENSE, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DRAINAGE MANAGEMENT AND EROSION CONTROL AT ALL TIMES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD.
14. THE CONTRACTOR, AT HIS EXPENSE, SHALL PROMPTLY CLEAN UP ANY MATERIAL EXCAVATED WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY OR PRIVATE ROADWAY EASEMENTS SO THAT THE EXCAVATED MATERIAL IS NOT SUSCEPTIBLE TO BEING WASHED DOWN THE STREET OR INTO ANY PUBLIC DRAINAGE FACILITY.
15. CONTRACTOR, AT HIS EXPENSE, SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION SIGNING UNTIL THE PROJECT HAS BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE.
16. ALL EXCAVATION, TRENCHING, AND SHORING ACTIVITES MUST BE CARRIED-OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH OSHA 29 CFR 1926.650 SUBPART P AND COA STD. DWG. 2465.
17. IF A PAVEMENT DROP-OFF IS CREATED DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INITIATE PROTECTIVE ACTION TO MAINTAIN A SMOOTH TRANSITION. THIS WORK SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO BID ITEMS 5 & 6.
18. A FOG SEAL COAT SHALL BE APPLIED TO ALL NEW AND EXISTING PAVEMENTS PRIOR TO FINAL STRIPING OF THE PROJECT. LIMITS OF THE COAT SHALL BE THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE PROJECT AND INCIDENTAL TO BID ITEMS 5 & 6.
19. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL POTENTIAL OBSTRUCTIONS. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY PROJECT MANAGER OR CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY AND COVERED THROUGH THE UTILITY RELOCATION ALLOWANCE ESTABLISHED FOR THIS PROJECT.

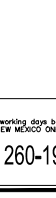

IDENTIFICATION OF A SITE AND VERIFICATION OF SITE SUITABILITY IS CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO PROJECT BID ITEM #28.
22. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING THE EXISTING UTILITY LINES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREA. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING FACILITIES CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE AND APPROVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER.

26. ALL BARRICADES AND CONSTRUCTION SIGNING SHALL CONFORM TO APPLICABLE SECTIONS OF THE M.U.T.C.D., U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, LATEST EDITION.
27. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES AND SIGNING AT ALL TIMES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE PROPER LOCATION OF ALL BARRICADING AT THE END AND BEGINNING OF EACH DAY.
28. 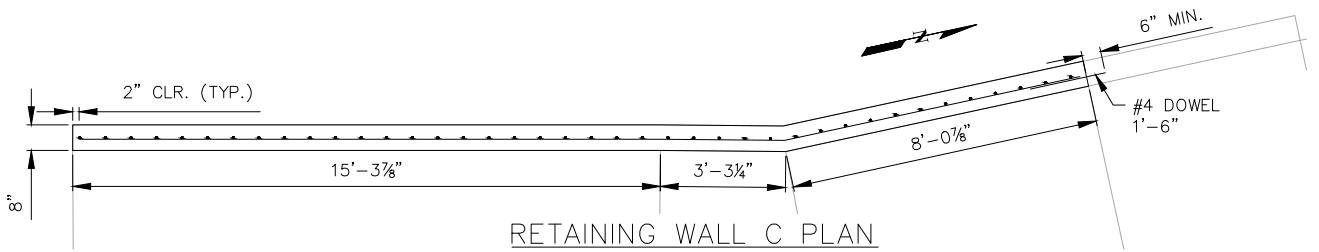

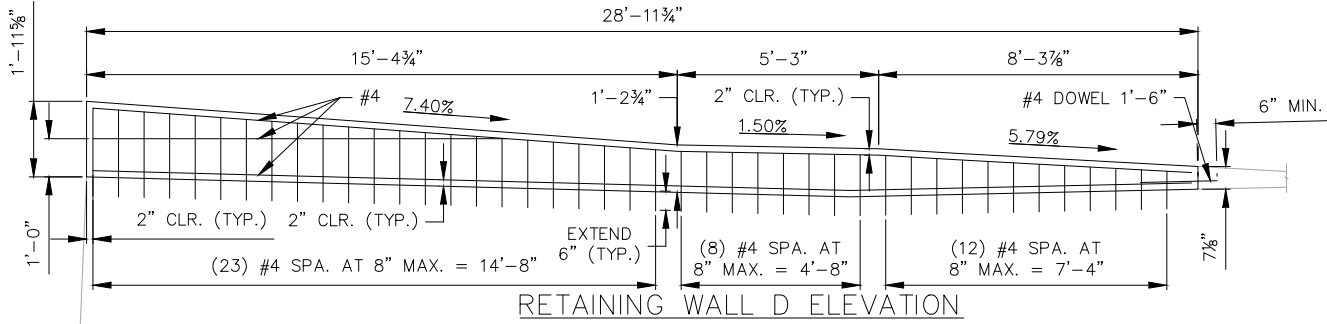
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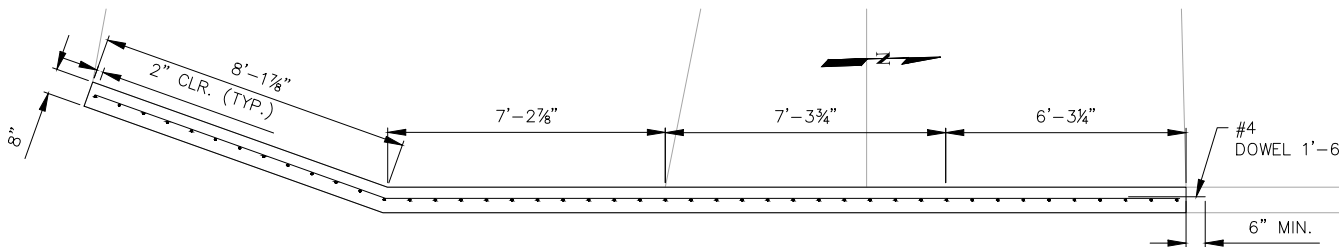
RETAINING WALL C ELEVATION



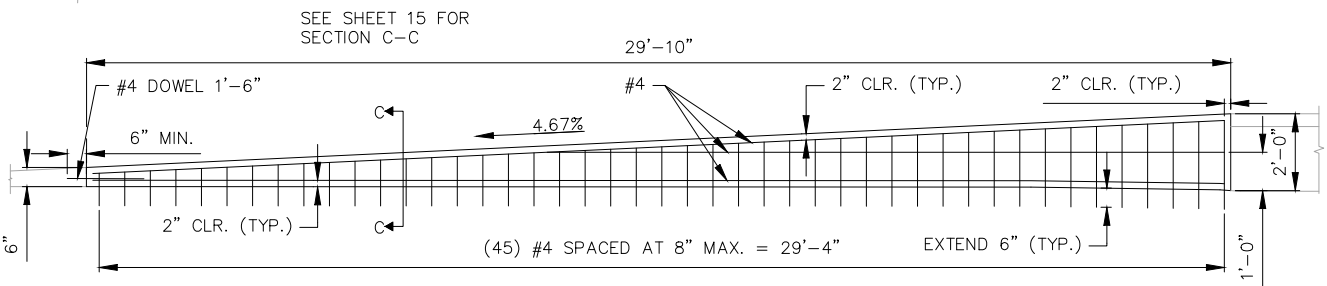
RETAINING WALL C PLAN



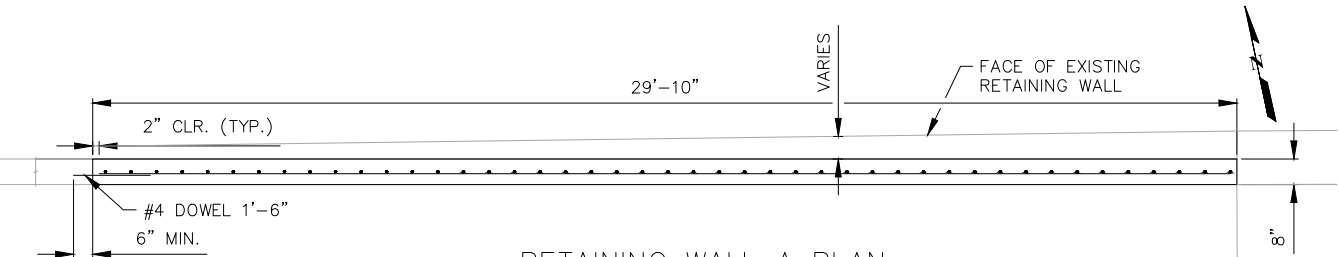

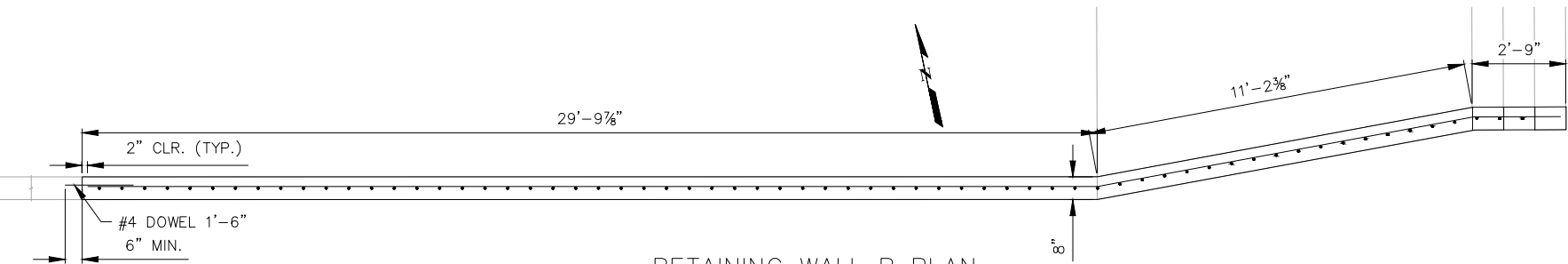

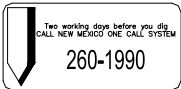


RETAINING WALL B ELEVATION
