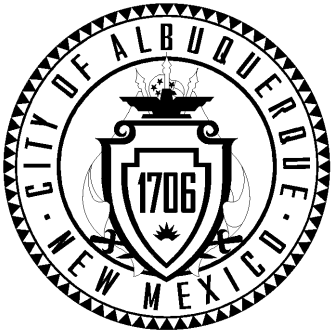
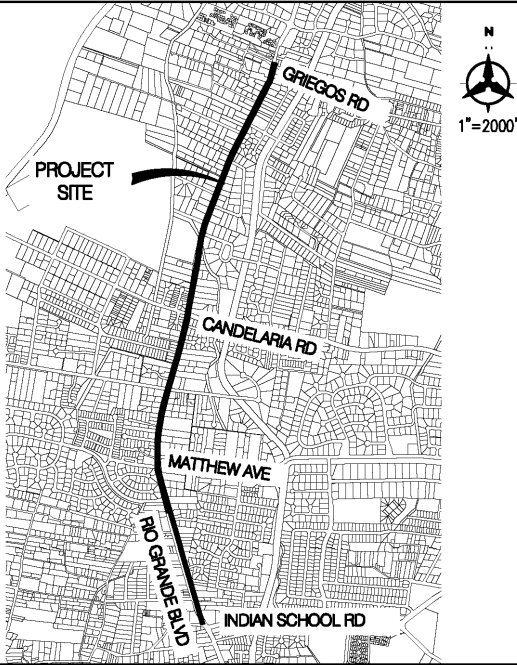

GENERAL NOTES

1. STRIPING & PAVEMENT MARKING REMOVAL SHALL BE DONE USING WATER BLASTING. GRINDING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THIS PROJECT.
2. CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A GRAFFITI FREE WORK SITE. GRAFFITI SHALL BE REMOVED WITHIN 24 HOURS.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ABIDE BY ALL LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH APPLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS.
2. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING THE EXISTING UTILITY LINES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREA. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING FACILITIES CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE AND APPROVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION ENGINEER.
3. CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE PROPERTY AND/OR PROJECT LIMITS. ANY DAMAGE TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES RESULTING FROM THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. ANY COSTS INCURRED FOR REPAIRS SHALL BE THE COST OF THE CONTRACTOR.
4. OVERNIGHT PARKING OF CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT OBSTRUCT DRIVEWAYS OR DESIGNATED TRAFFIC LANES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT STORE ANY EQUIPMENT OR MATERIAL WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.
5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ALL THE NECESSARY PERMITS FOR THE PROJECT PRIOR TO COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION (I.E. BARRICADING, SURFACE DISTURBANCE).
6. ALL BARRICADES AND CONSTRUCTION SIGNAGE SHALL CONFORM TO APPLICABLE SECTIONS OF THE "MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" (MUTCD), U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, 2009 EDITION WITH REVISION #1 AND #2.
7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES AND SIGNING AT ALL TIMES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE PROPER LOCATION OF ALL BARRICADING AT THE END AND BEGINNING OF EACH DAY.
8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENTS, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, CURB & GUTTER, DRIVE PADS, SIGNAGE, CURB RAMPS, SIDEWALKS, WATER AND SANITARY SEWER LINES DURING CONSTRUCTION, APART FROM THOSE SECTIONS INDICATED FOR REMOVAL ON THE PLANS AND SHALL REPAIR OR REPLACE PER COA STANDARDS, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE.
9. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION SIGNAGE UNTIL THE PROJECT HAS BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE.
10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO REPLACE AT HIS EXPENSE ANY AND ALL PROPERTY CORNERS DESTROYED DURING CONSTRUCTION. ALL PROPERTY CORNERS MUST BE RESET BY A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR.
11. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH ALL AFFECTED BUSINESSES & RESIDENCES IN THE PROJECT AREA. ACCESS TO ALL BUSINESSES & RESIDENCES SHALL REMAIN OPEN AT ALL TIMES.
12. AS BUILT PLANS OR REDLINES SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT IF THE PLANS ARE CHANGED.
13. ALL SALVAGEABLE MATERIAL (SIGNS) SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE CITY AT THE PINO YARDS, NEAR I-25 AND PASEO DEL NORTE.
14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT AND OBTAIN APPROVAL OF A TRAFFIC CONTROL PERMIT PRIOR TO COMMENCING ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ON THE ROADWAY. ALONG WITH THE PERMIT, THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN THAT WILL REFLECT AND COORDINATE THE CONTRACTOR'S PROPOSED PHASING. THE PLANS SHALL BE PREPARED AND SEALED MY A NEW MEXICO REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER. THE PLANS BE REVIEWED BY CITY PERMITTING.
15. TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHOULD NOTIFY THE TRANSIT DEPARTMENT OF ANY IMPACT THE PROPOSED PROJECT WILL HAVE ON THE TRANSIT SYSTEM SUCH AS CAUSING A DETOUR OR RESULTING IN THE CLOSING OR RELOCATION OF A BUS STOP. THE CONTACT PERSON IS:

16. TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION VARIABLE MESSAGE BOARDS SHALL BE PLACED THOUGHT THE PROJECT TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE UPCOMING PROJECT. THEY SHALL BE PLACED IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:NB RIO GRANDE NEAR MATTHEW AVE, SB RIO GRANDE NEAR MATTHEW, EB AND WB CANDELARIA NEAR RIO GRANDE. THE MESSAGE SHALL STATE THE START DATE OF THE PROJECT.
17. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PREFORMED UNDER CONTACT SHALL, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED FOR HEREON, BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, 1986 EDITION AS REVISED THROUGH UPDATE 9.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR

1. AN EXCAVATION/CONSTRUCTION PERMIT WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK WITHIN THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.
2. ALL WORK DETAILED ON THESE PLANS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER CONTRACT SHALL, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED OR PROVIDED FOR HEREON, BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, 1986 EDITION AS REVISED THROUGH UPDATE NO. 9.
3. TWO WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT NEW MEXICO ONE CALL SYSTEM (260-1990 OR 811) FOR LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES.
4. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL OBSTRUCTIONS. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER OR SURVEYOR IMMEDIATELY SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY.
5. SEVEN (7) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT, TO THE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES DIVISION, A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A BARRICADING PERMIT FROM THE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY CONSTRUCTION SERVICES ENGINEER (924-3400) PRIOR TO OCCUPYING AN INTERSECTION. REFER TO SECTION 19 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
6. ALL LONGITUDINAL STRIPING ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED W/ REFLECTORIZED PAINTED PAVEMENT MARKINGS BY THE CONTRACTOR TO THE SAME LOCATION AS EXISTING, OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET. ALL TRANSVERSE STRIPING OR PAVEMENT MARKINGS ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED W/ REFLECTORIZED PLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING BY THE CONTRACTOR TO THE SAME LOCATION AS EXISTING, OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.
7. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER NOT LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO STARTING WORK IN ORDER THAT THE CITY SURVEYOR MAY TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES TO ENSURE THE PRESERVATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT DISTURB PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENTS WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE CITY SURVEYOR AND SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR AND BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE DISTURBED WITHOUT PERMISSION. REPLACEMENT SHALL BE DONE ONLY BY THE CITY SURVEYOR. WHEN A CHANGE IS MADE IN THE FINISHED ELEVATIONS OF THE PAVEMENT OF ANY ROADWAY IN WHICH A PERMANENT SURVEY MONUMENT IS LOCATED, CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE, ADJUST THE MONUMENT COVER TO THE NEW GRADE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED. REFER TO SECTION 4.4 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
8. CONTRACTOR SHALL RECORD DATA ON ALL UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES AS REQUIRED BY THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE FOR THE PREPARATION OF "AS CONSTRUCTED" DRAWINGS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT COVER UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES UNTIL ALL DATA HAS BEEN RECORDED.
9. CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A CLEAN WORK SITE. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROMPTLY REMOVE ANY GRAFFITI WITH-IN 24 HOURS FROM ALL EQUIPMENT, WHETHER PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY.
10. ALL SIGN POSTS SHALL BE HAND DUG TO PROTECT UTILITIES.
