12DRB-70362 VACATION OF ACCESS & UTILITY EASEMENTS

MYERS, OLIVER & PRICE, P.C. agent(s) for MESA DEL SOL LLC request(s) the referenced/ above action(s) on Tract 8, **BULK LAND PLAT of MESA DEL SOL** zoned PC, located in the southwest corner of the intersection of I-25 and NM 47, containing approximately 23.5768 acre(s). (U-13)

At the December 12, 2012 Development Review Board meeting, the vacation was approved as shown on Exhibit B in the Planning file per section 14-14-7-2(A)(1) and (B) (1)(3) of the Subdivision Ordinance. Additional documentation for tract 8 access must be provided.

Findings

- (A)(1) The vacation of public right-of-way request was filed by the owners of a majority of the footage of land abutting the proposed vacation.
- (B)(1) The applicant has agreed that the original easement may have platted in error, and subject to documentation of adequate access, the City of Albuquerque would concur that thepublic welfare is in no way served by retaining the easements.
- (B)(3) There is no convincing evidence that any substantial property right is being abridged against the will of the owner of the right. Property owners of record abutting the proposed vacation were notified by first class mail at least six days prior to the Development Review Board hearing, notice was published in a newspaper of general circulation 15 days before the date of the hearing, and signs were posted on the site 15 days prior to the hearing; no objection regarding access or the abridgement of a substantial property right was raised.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Access to public right of way for Tract 8 must be documented with the application to the Development Review Board for the required replat.
- 2. The vacated property shall be shown on a replat approved by the Development Review Board and the approved replat shall be filed for record with the Bernalillo County Clerk's Office within one year.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you must do so by December 27, 2012 in the manner described below.

Appeal is to the Land Use Hearing Officer. Any person aggrieved with any determination of the Development Review Board may file an appeal on the Planning Department form, to the Planning Department, within 15 days of the Development Review Board's decision.

The date the determination in question is issued is not included in the 15-day period for filing an appeal.

If the fifteenth day falls on a Saturday, Sunday or holiday as listed in the Merit System Ordinance, the next working day is considered as the deadline for filing the appeal. Such appeal shall be heard within 60 days of its filing.

You will receive notice if any other person files an appeal. Successful applicants are reminded that other requirements of the City must be complied with, even after approval of the referenced application(s).

Please note that the vacation of all plats, rights-of-way, and easements are void after one year from the final appeal date referenced above if all conditions are not met (The effective date of Development Review Board approval is the hearing date plus the 15-day appeal period.) (REF: Chapter 14 Article 14 Part 7-2 (E)(3)(6) Revised Ordinance.)
