LEGAL DESCRIPTION



A certain parcel of land comprising Tracts A, B, and E, Matthew Meadow, as the same are shown and designated on the Plat thereof titled "Amended Matthew Meadow, A Subdivision, Albuquerque, New Mexico, being a Replat of Tracts A, B, & C of Indian Farms and Tract 106 Map 34 M.R.G.C.D.", said plat being filed in the office of the Bernalillo County Clerk on November 21, 1978 in Volume D9, Folio 29, said parcel being more particularly described by grid bearings (New Mexico Coordinate System — Central Zone, NAD 27) and horizontal ground distances as follows:

Beginning at a point on the present (2005) easterly Right—of—Way line of Mateo Prado N.W., said point of beginning being the northwest corner of said Tract A, and the southwest corner of Lot 1, Block 4, of said Matthew Meadow Subdivision, a 5/8" rebar and red plastic cap marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey, from which the City of Albuquerque Control Monument 6—G13A RESET (a 3 1/2" brass cap in concrete stamped "6—G13A RESET 1980/1995") bears N38*32'47"W a distance of 2169.28 feet;

Thence, N 88'48'31" E, a distance of 482.10 feet along the northerly boundary line of said Tract A and the southerly boundary line of said Block 4 to the northeast corner of said Tract A, said northeast corner being the southeast corner of Lot 5, Block 4, of said Matthew Meadow Subdivision, and being a point on the westerly boundary line of said Tract B, a 5/8" rebar and red plastic cap marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, N 07"13"52" W, a distance of 238.19 feet along the easterly boundary line of said Lot 5, and the westerly boundary line of said Tract B to the point of intersection with the present (2005) easterly Right—of—Way line of Camino Ecuestre N.W., said point also being the northeast corner of said Lot 5, a 1/2" rebar found in place;

Thence, N 07'13'52" W, a distance of 136.20 feet along said present easterly Right—of—Way line and said westerly boundary line to a point of curvature, a 5/8" rebar found in place;

Thence, northeasterly along said present easterly Right—of—Way line on a curve (radius = 80.39 feet, chord = N18°21'33"E a chord distance of 69.45 feet) through an arc of 51°10'50" to the right a distance of 71.81 feet to the point of intersection of said easterly Right—of Way line with the easterly boundary line of said Tract B, said point of intersection also being the northeast corner of said Tract B and the northwest corner of Lot 33, Block 6, of said Matthew Meadow Subdivision, a 5/8" rebar found in place;

Thence, S 07"13'52" E, a distance of 154.45 feet along said easterly boundary line and the westerly boundary line of said Lot 33 to the southwest corner of said Lot 33, a 5/8" rebar and red plastic cap marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, S 07°13'52" E, a distance of 282.95 feet along said easterly boundary line and the westerly line of an existing unplatted irrigation ditch to an angle point, a 5/8" rebar and red plastic cap marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, S 05°47'52" E, a distance of 339.51 feet along said easterly boundary line and the westerly line of said ditch to the point of intersection with the present (2005) northerly Right—of—Way line of Matthew Avenue N.W., said point also being the southeast corner of said Tract B, a 5/8" rebar and red plastic cap marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, N 89°08'12" W, a distance of 90.00 feet along said present northerly Right—of—Way line and the southerly boundary lines of said Tracts B and E to an angle point, a MAG nail and washer marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, N 89°32'48" W, a distance of 360.00 feet along said present northerly Right—of—Way line and the southerly boundary lines of said Tracts A and E to a point of curvature, a MAG nail and washer marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, northwesterly along said present northerly Right-of-Way line and said southerly boundary of Tract A on a curve (radius = 25.00 feet, chord = N45°26'57"W a chord distance of 35.35 feet) through an arc of 89°58'36" to the right a distance of 39.26 feet to a point of reverse curvature, said point being a point on the present (2005) easterly Right-of-Way line of Mateo Prado N.W., a MAG nail and washer marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, northwesterly along said present easterly Right—of—Way line and the westerly boundary of said Tract A on a curve (radius = 375.00 feet, chord = N12*27'14"W a chord distance of 155.93 feet) through an arc of 24*00'00" to the left a distance of 157.08 feet to a point of reverse curvature, a 5/8" rebar and red plastic cap marked "S. TOLER N.M.P.S. 11599" set this survey;

Thence, northwesterly along said present easterly Right-of-Way line and said westerly boundary on a curve (radius = 425.70 feet, chord = N14°04'32"W a chord distance of 153.38 feet) through an arc of 24°45'23" to the right a distance of 154.22 feet to the point and place of beginning. Said parcel contains 3.9982 acres, more or less.




