If in the opinion of the Grantee, the Work to be performed by any Grantee could endanger the structural integrity or otherwise damage the Improvements or encroachments, the Grantors shall, at their own expense, take whatever protective measures are required to safeguard the Improvements or encroachments.

- 2. <u>Warranties.</u> Grantors covenant and warrant that they are the owners in fee simple of the Property, that they have a good lawful right to convey the Property or any part thereof, and that the Grantors will forever warrant and defend the title to the Property against all claims from all persons or entities.
- 3. <u>Binding on Grantor's Property</u>. The grant and other provisions of this Easement constitute covenants running with the title to the Property for the benefit of the Grantee, and their respective successors and assigns until terminated.

This Easement shall not be effective until approved by the City Engineer in the signature block below.
