DISCLOSURE STATEMENT


The purpose of this replat is to combine Parcels A-1 and A-2, Indian School Property-Joint Venture and Tract A-2, Netherwood Park Addition, into two (2) tracts, show the vacation of a public utility easement, to grant additional easements as shoen hereon, and to dedicate to the City of Albuquerque in fee simple the Bikeway as shown hereon.

There is a Reciprocal Access and Maintenance Agreement between the owners of Parcels A-1 and A-2 of the Indian School Property-Joint Venture filed in the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, New Mexico, on October 30, 1984, in Volume Misc. 169A, folio 505-511.

Included, is the right to build, rebuild, construct, reconstruct, locate, relocate, change, remove, modify, renew, operate, and maintain facilities for the purposes described above, together with free access to, from, and over said easements, including sufficient working area space for electric transformers, with the right and privilege to trim and remove trees, shrubs or bushes which interfere with the purposes set forth herein. No building, sign, pool (aboveground or subsurface), hot tub, concrete or wood pool decking, or other structure shall be erected or constructed on said easements, nor shall any well be drilled or operated thereon. Property owners shall be solely responsible for correcting any violations of National Electrical Safety Code by construction of pools, decking, or any structures adjacent to or near easements shown on this plat.
