On November 1, 2017, the DRB approved a one year extension which, including the 15 day appeal period, meant the Extension of Subdivision Improvement Agreement would have expired on November 16, 2018.

Successful applicants are reminded that there may be other City regulations of the IDO that must be complied with, even after approval of the referenced application(s).
