This request is for the variance to be granted for a proposed carport at 905 Georgia St SE.

The proposed carport will strengthen the architectural character of the surrounding area because it gives an ornamental appearance with color to match the home. This will result in a pleasing and attractive structure which will increase the value of the home. (Please view attached image)
