




COMMISSION ORDINANCE NO. 1940

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING, APPROVING AND CON-FIRMING ACTION DIRECTED TOWARD THE IMPROVE-MENT OF CERTAIN STREETS IN ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO, STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 128, AND THE ISSUANCE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH IN CASE OF DELINQUENCY; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT BONDS; PRE-SCRIBING DETAILS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of in the County of Bornalillo and State of New Mexico, tofore, pursuant to the requisite preliminary proceedings, for the grading, gravelling, paving, macadamizing, storm sewering, curbing, guttering, and otherwise imof certain streets, and parts thereof, with intersecn said City, more particularly specified in Commission te No. 1905, of said City, passed, adopted, signed and on the 11th day of April , 1978, said improveaving been sometimes designated as "Albuquerque, New Mexico, Improvement District No. 128 , and also known as "Paving No. 128," and by said proceedings and ordinances ded valid assessments to defray a portion of the cost therehe total amount of \$716,851.40 against the property My benefited by said improvements, all in accordance with tutes of the State of New Mexico providing therefor; and WHEREAS, pursuant to said proceeding, the City ion duly and validly proceeded to advertise for the doing work therefor, and the City formally entered into a conon the 21st day of February, 1961, for the doing of

WHEREAS, thereafter the City Commission determined, and does hereby determine, that the lowest cost of such improvements, including all advertising, appraising, engineering, legal, printing and other incidental costs, is the sum of \$739,935.38, and

WHEREAS, said City Commission has determined, and does hereby determine, that said total cost of such improvements, including advertising, appraising, engineering, legal, printing, street improvement bonds discount, and other incidental costs, shall be paid for by the property specially benefitted by said improvements in accordance with the law, except for the sum of \$23,083.98 which is available to defray a portion of said cost from sources other than assessments; and

WHEREAS, a portion of said assessments, i.e. \$ 206,851.40 has been paid in cash; and

WHEREAS, there remain unpaid valid special assessments in the amount of \$510,000.00 payable in twenty substantially equal semi-annual installments of principal, until paid in full, with interest in all cases on the unpaid and deferred installments of principal from the date of publication of said Commission Ordinance No. 1905 after its passage and approval, i.e. from the 11th day of April , 1961, at the rate of six and one-half per centum (6-1/2%) per annum, both principal and interest being payable semi-annually at the office of the City Treasurer on the first days of April and October in each year, commencing the first day of October , 1961; and the City of Albuquerque desires to issue its special assessment, negotiable, coupon bonds in the amount of \$510.000.00 to pay in part the cost and expenses of constructing and making said improvements, pursuant to provisions of Sections 14-37-16 to 14-37-22, both

inclusive, and lu-41-3, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1953, and all laws supplemental thereto: and

WHEREAS, there has been filed in the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, New Mexico, on the 2nd day of June, 1961, a claim of lien for the amount due and assessed and remaining unpaid, as aforesaid, which claim of lien now remains of record in the office of said County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque levies a tax of one-half of one cent per gallon on each gallon of gasoline and motor fuel sold within the City of Albuquerque pursuant to the provisions of Commission Ordinance No. 784, passed, adopted, signed and approved the 25th day of March, 1952, and

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has created "Special Street Improvement Fund No. 128 by Commission Ordinance No. 1939, passed, adopted, signed, and approved this 6th day of June , 1961.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE, BERNALILLO COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That all action, proceedings, matters and things (not inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance), heretofore taken, had and done by the City of Albuquerque and the officers of said City concerning the grading, gravelling, paving, macademizing, drainage, storm sewering, curbing, guttering, and otherwise improving certain streets, and parts thereof, with intersections, in what has sometimes been designated as "Albuquerque, New Mexico, Street Improvement District

No. 128 ," within and for said Lity, the levying and perfecting of special assessments to meet a part of the cost thereof, and the issuance of its "City of Albuquerque, New Mexico, Street Improvement District No. 128, Street Improvement Bonds, issue of , 1961," for that purpose, be, and the same is June 1 hereby ratified, approved and confirmed, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the sale of said bonds bearing interest as hereinafter provided, to Kirchner, Ormsbee and Wiesner, Inc., Denver, Colorado, and associates, for the price of \$971/54 for each bond in the denomination of \$1,000, and accrued interest thereon from its date to the date of its delivery (provided, however, the City retains the right not to sell and deliver all or any portion of the last twenty per centum (20% of said bonds, i.e. bonds numbered 409 to 510, both inclusive, in the principal amount of \$ 102,000.00

Section 2. That the City of Albuquerque, and it hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed, and it shall be its duty to receive, collect and enforce the payment of all assessments made and levied for said improvements, and all installments thereof, all interest thereon, and all penalties accrued, as provided by law and in the same manner and at the same time or times as prescribed by Commission Ordinance No.

approved on the <u>llth</u> day of <u>April</u>, 1961, and by this ordinance, and to pay and disburse said payments, the installments thereof, the interest thereon, and penalties thereto, to any person or persons lawfully entitled thereto.

Section 3. That the Treasurer of the City of Albuquerque be, and he hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed, and it shall be his duty, to receive and collect all assess-

ments, levied to pay the cost of said improvement, the installments thereof, the interest thereon, and the penalties accrued, at the time and in the manner heretofore specified, and to pay and disburse such payments to the person or persons lawfully entitled to receive the same, in accordance with the laws of the State of New Mexico and all the ordinances and resolutions of said City heretofore or to be hereafter adopted. All monies received from such assessments from and after the 19th day of 19 61 (which remain payable in installments as provided by said Commission Ordinance No. 1905), shall be placed in a separate fund to be designated "City of Albuquerque, Street Improvement District No. 128, Street Improvement Bonds, Issue of 1, 1961, Special Assessments Interest and Bond Retirement Fund," herein sometimes merely designated as the "Bond Fund," and shall be used as soon as they are available for the purpose of paying the principal of and interest on the street improvement bonds hereinafter mentioned, and for no other purpose whatsoever, and as security for such payment said fund is hereby exclusively pledged, except as otherwise specifically provided. The monies, whether represented by cash or securities, in the Special Street Improvement Fund No. 128, created by said Commission Ordinance No. 1939, herein sometimes designated merely as the "Security Fund," shall be used to pay interest on and the principal of said bonds or for their repurchase and prior redemption, as therein provided, and for no other purpose, except as therein otherwise provided. For all disbursements from said Security Fund, the City of Albuquerque shall be subrogated for the benefit of said Security Fund to all the

rights and remedies of the holder or holders of said bonds. All of said bonds so repurchased and redeemed prior to their scheduled maturity date with monies from said Security Fund, shall be cancelled forthwith. The City, upon the collection of any delinquent assessments, principal, interest and the penalty, may reimburse itself therefrom to the extent of the deposits theretofore made into the Security Fund with such gasoline and motor fuel tax proceeds and not theretofore so reimbursed; and the City, from such delinquent assessment collections, during the eleven year pledge period designated in said Commission Ordinance No. 1939, and without any preliminaries other than compliance with the conditions thereof limiting withdrawals, may withdraw at one time or from time to time monies equal to such reimbursements for use in its general fund or any other fund the City Commission may lawfully determine. The City Treasurer be, and he also hereby is authorized, empowered and directed, and it shall be his duty, to receive and collect all of the receipts of municipal taxes levied and collected from the sale of gasoline and motor fuel, to place said monies in the said Security Fund, to the extent heretofore provided, to disburse therefrom said monies for the payment of the interest on and principal of the bonds hereinafter authorized, as the same become due, if necessary, and to otherwise maintain and manage said fund in the manner heretofore specified. The monies in said Bond Fund and Security Fund shall each constitute a trust fund and shall be deposited in a bank qualified to accept trust funds under the laws governing the acceptance of trust funds. The fees, if any, of the trustee shall be paid from monies in each of said funds. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as repealing or amending any provision of said Commission Ordinance No. ____, by which the Security Fund has been declared to be created.

Section 4. That if the owner of any lot or parcel of land assessed for said improvements shall be delinquent for a period of sixty (60) days in the payment of any assessment installment due, either principal or interest or both, it shall be the duty of the City Commission to cause Kirchner, Ormsbee & Wiesner, Inc., Denver, Colorado, as representative of the original purchasers of the bonds herein authorized to be issued, and as representative of the bondholders from time to time, and such delinquent persons to be immediately notified of such delinquency, in writing, and if such delinquency shall not be paid within ten days after such notice shall have been given, then said City Commission, at its own expense, shall forthwith foreclose the special assessment lien against the property or properties wherein the delinquency exists in the method now or hereafter provided by statute for the foreclosure of mortgages on real estate, or otherwise as provided by law, and at such sale said property shall be bought in by the City for not less than the amount of the balance due on the assessment, principal, interest, penalty, and costs, if there be no other purchaser therefor. If said foreclosure be not promptly filed and prosecuted, then any bondholder may file and prosecute said foreclosure action in the name of said City or may proceed against the City as heretofore provided. Except for the reimbursement of the proceeds from the municipal tax on gasoline and motor fuel used for the payment of the interest on and the principal of said bonds, as heretofore provided, all the net proceeds of collecting any delinquent assessment shall be deposited in the Bond Fund, and in any event in an amount of not less than

the principal amount of said assessment and accrued interest thereon to the date of its collection.

Section 5. That if any property shall be offered for sale for the non-payment of any assessment, installment thereof or interest or penalty thereon, and no person or persons shall bid for said property, then the City shall have the power, and it shall be its duty to bid for said property from any funds available therefor, as aforesaid, and to take and receive in its corporate name any certificates or deeds to said property for the benefit of the owner or owners of the street improvement bonds hereinafter specified. Said City shall have the power to lease or sell said property, and all of the net proceeds of any such lease or sale shall be deposited in the said Bond Fund.

Section 6. That for the purpose of defraying the entire cost and expense of making said improvements, except to the extent funds are available therefor from that part of said assessments which have been heretofore paid and to the extent other funds are available therefor, there be issued in the name of the City of Albuquerque special assessment, negotiable, coupon, bonds designated the "City of Albuquerque, New Mexico, Street Improvement District No. 128, Street Improvement Bonds, Issue of June 1 , 1961," in the aggregate principal amount of \$ 510,000.00 , consisting of 510 bonds, numbered consecutively from 1 to 510, both inclusive, which bonds shall bear date as of the first day of June, 1961, shall be in the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, shall be payable in regular numerical order on the first day of May, 1971, and shall bear interest payable on the first day of November, 1961,

and semi annually thereafter on the first day of May and November in each year at the rates hereinafter designated, as evidenced from the bond date until maturity by coupons designated "A" attached to each of said bonds, and as additionally evidenced from the 1561, until and including the dates hereinafter indicated as the "Final 'B' Interest Payment Date" by a second set of coupons designated "B" attached to said bonds, as follows:

If, upon presentation of any bond at maturity, payment is not made as therein provided, interest thereon shall continue at the rate of six and one-half per centum (6-1/2%) per annum until the principal thereof is paid in full. Said bonds and the coupons thereto attached shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America, without deduction for exchange or collection charges, at the office of the City Treasurer, City of Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Section 7. That all of said bonds shall be subject to prior redemption in regular numerical order at the option of the City on any interest payment date prior to maturity, at a price equal to the principal amount thereof with accrued interest to the redemption date. After any assessment installment

payment date, as specified in said assessment ordinance, i.e. Commission Ordinance No. 1905, if the monies in the Bond Fund exceed the interest becoming due on the bonds on their next succeeding interest payment date which is prior to the bond maturity date, i.e. prior to the first day of May 1971, the Treasurer shall forthwith call a number of the bonds to the extent such excess monies are sufficient therefor. Notice of prior redemption shall be given by the City Treasurer in the name of the City of Albuquerque by publication of such notice at least once in each calendar week on any day of the week for at least two successive weeks, the first publication to be at least fifteen days prior to the redemption date, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Albuquerque, and a copy of such notice shall be sent by registered mail at least fifteen days prior to the redemption date to Kirchner, Ormsbee & Wiesner, Inc., Denver, Colorado. Such notice shall specify the number or numbers of the bonds to be so redeemed (if less than all are to be redeemed) and the date fixed for redemption, and shall further state that on such redemption date there will become and be due and payable upon each bond so to be redeemed at the office of the Treasurer in the City of Albuquerque, the principal amount thereof with accrued interest to the redemption date, and that from and after such date interest will cease to accrue. Notice having been given in the manner hereinbefore provided, the bond or bonds so called for redemption shall become due and payable on the redemption date so designated; and upon presentation thereof at the office of the City Treasurer, together with all appurtenant "A" coupons maturing subsequent to the redemption date, the City of Albuquerque will pay the bond or bonds so called for redemption.

Section 8. That the bonds herein authorized to be issued may be refunded in accordance with and under the conditions imposed by the laws of the State of New Mexico and said City in force at the effective date of this ordinance and not otherwise; provided, however, that none of said bonds shall be called for prior redemption for the purpose of refunding them, and that none of said bonds shall be refunded unless there is not, and unless it is certain that there will not be, a sufficient amount of money in the Bond Fund and the Security Fund to pay such bonds and the interest thereon, as such becomes due.

Section 9. That said bonds shall be fully negotiable and shall have all the qualities of negotiable paper, subject to the payment provisions stated herein, and the holder or holders thereof shall possess all rights enjoyed by holders of negotiable instruments under the provisions of the Negotiable Instruments Law.

Section 10. That said bonds shall be signed and executed with the engraved, imprinted, stamped or otherwise reproduced facsimiles of the signatures of the Chairman of the City Commission and ex-officio Mayor of the City of Albuquerque and of the City Treasurer of the City of Albuquerque; each bond shall be attested, manually subscribed and executed by the City Clerk of the City of Albuquerque. There shall be affixed on each bond the printed, engraved, stamped or otherwise placed thereon facsimile of the corporate seal of the City. The coupons attached to said bonds shall bear the facsimile signature of the City Treasurer, which officer, by the execution of said bonds, shall adopt as and for his signature the facsimile thereof appearing on said coupons, and when said bonds are executed, said coupons shall constitute the binding obligations of said City for said interest. Said bonds and coupons bearing the manual and facsimile signatures of the officers in office at the time of the signing thereof shall be valid and binding obligations of the City of Albuquerque, notwithstanding that

before the delivery thereof and payment therefor, any or all of the persons whose signatures appear thereon shall have ceased to fill their respective offices. The Chairman of the City Commission and ex-officio Mayor of the City of Albuquerque, and the City Treasurer, at the time of the execution of the bonds and the signature certificate, each may adopt as and for his own facsimile signature the facsimile signature of his predecessor in office in the event that such facsimile signature appears upon any of the bonds or coupons pertaining to the bonds herein authorized to be issued.

Section 11. That said bonds and the interest thereon shall be payable solely (except as hereinafter provided) from the Bond Fund, consisting of monies collected from the assessments levied to pay for said improvements, provided that any proceeds from the sale of the bonds remaining after the payment of the cost and expense of making said improvements shall be used therefor; but said bonds shall be additionally secured and the payment of the principal thereof and the interest thereon shall be supplemented by the gasoline and motor fuel tax monies in said Security Fund, which fund is and shall be irrevocably pledged for a period not exceeding eleven years from the date of said bonds for the full and prompt payment of the interest on and principal of said bonds, as more specifically heretofore provided.

Section 12. That the obligations created by these aforesaid payment provisions shall not be construed or held to make said bonds general obligations of the City, and the owner or owners, or holder or holders, of said bonds shall have no claim on any general or other fund for the payment thereof, except as heretofore provided. The bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not be a debt of the City, nor shall it thereby pledge its full faith and credit for their payment. The payment of the bonds is not secured by an encumbrance, mortgage or other pledge of property of the City except for such special assessments and other monies specifically pledged for the payment of bonds. No property

of the City, subject to said exceptions, shall be liable to be forfeited or taken in payment of the bonds.

Section 14. That when said bonds have been duly executed and registered, the City Treasurer shall deliver them to the lawful purchasers thereof on receipt of the purchase price. The funds realized from the sale of the bonds shall be applied solely to defray the cost and expense of making said improvements; provided, however, that after said cost and expenses are paid (excepting any portion to be paid with other than special assessment proceeds), any funds remaining from the sale of said bonds shall be deposited in the Bond Fund and used for the purposes therefor specified hereinabove in Section 3 of this ordinance; and provided, further, that all monies received as accrued interest at the time of delivery of any of said bonds, if any, shall be deposited into the Bond Fund to apply on the payment of interest next due on said bonds. The purchaser of said bonds, however, shall in no manner be responsible for the application by said City, or any of its officers, of any of the funds derived from the sale thereof or of any other funds herein designated.

Section 15. That so long as any of said bonds remain outstanding, said City will keep or cause to be kept true and accurate books of records and accounts showing full and true entries covering the collection and disposition of said special assessments and said monies derived from said gasoline and motor fuel tax, as well as any delinquencies in the collection thereof, covering deposits and disbursements in the Bond Fund and the Security Fund, covering the redemption of said bonds, both principal and interest, and covering disbursements to defray the costs of said improvements, including incidental

expenses; and said City will permit an inspection and examination of all books and accounts at all reasonable times by any representative of any of the original purchasers of said bonds. In addition, said City at least once a year will cause at its regular annual audit, an audit to be made relating to said books and accounts by an accountant to be employed by the City at its completion will be furnished by the City, without charge, to said Kirchner, Ormsbee & Wiesner, Inc., as representative of the bondholders from time to time.

Section 16. That the officers of the City be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this ordinance, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the printing of said bonds, the use of facsimile signatures and of the facsimile seal of said City on said bonds, and the execution of such certificates as may reasonably be required by the purchasers thereof, relating, among other matters, to the signing of the bonds, the tenure and identity of the municipal officials, the amount certified on the assessment roll together with the amount of cash payments, the accuracy of property descriptions, the delivery of the bonds, and the absence of litigation pending or threatened affecting the validity of the bonds, if such is in accordance with the facts.

Section 17. That any holder of any one or more of said bonds, or any of the coupons representing interest thereon, may, either at law or in equity, by suit, action, mandamus or other appropriate proceeding in any court of competent

jurisdiction, protect the liens created by this ordinance on the proceeds of said assessments and gasoline and motor fuel tax levies, and may by suit, action, mandamus, or other appropriate proceedings enforce and compel the performance of any duty imposed upon the City by the provisions of this ordinance, or any ordinance heretofore adopted concerning said Street Improvement District No. 128, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the segregation of special assessments and gasoline and motor fuel tax proceeds and revenues, the proper application thereof, and the appointment of a receiver. The failure of any bond-holder so to proceed shall not relieve the City or any of its officers, agents or employees of any liability for failure to perform any such duty.

Section 18. That said City hereby covenants that, subject to any constitutional limitations, so long as any of the bonds herein authorized remain unpaid, both as to principal and interest, and so long as any of said assessments levied against land owned by the City of Albuquerque, any other municipality, the United States of America, the State of New Mexico, or any county thereof, remain unpaid, as to principal, interest or any penalties, said City will levy a tax pursuant to Section 14-41-6, New Mexico Statutes, 1953, Annotated, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, sufficient to pay any such assessment, if necessary to insure the payment thereof.

Section 19. That all ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency.

This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or resolution, or part thereof, heretofore irrepealable until said bonds and the interest thereon shall be fully paid, certified and discharged, as herein provided.

Section 21. That this ordinance may be amended or supplemented by an ordinance or ordinances adopted by the City Commission in accordance with the laws of the State of New Mexico, and without the receipt by the City of any additional consideration, with the written consent of the holders of seventy-five per centum (75%) of the bonds authorized by this ordinance and outstanding at the time of the adoption of such amendatory or supplemental ordinance, provided, however, that no such ordinance shall have the effect of permitting:

- (a) An extension of the maturity of any bond authorized by this ordinance; or
- (b) A reduction in the principal amount of any bond or the rate of interest thereon; or
- (c) The creation of a lien upon or a pledge of property, revenues or funds, ranking prior to the liens or pledges created by this ordinance; or
- (d) A reduction of the principal amount of bonds required for consent to such amendatory or supplemental ordinance.

Section 22. That if any one or more sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance shall for any reason be questioned or held invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provisions of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its operation to the specific sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance so held unconstitutional and invalid, and the inapplicability

and invalidity of any section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance in any one or more instances shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of this ordinance in any other instances.

Section 23. That because of the fact the City does not now have adequate streets and it is necessary to defray forthwith the cost of improvements thereto, this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, New Mexico, and that this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Chairman of the City Commission and ex-officio Mayor, and the City Clerk, shall be published in the El Independiente and The New Mexico Independent, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City, and shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
