ENGINEERING COMMENTS:

1. It does not appear that any previous comments were addressed. Please provide existing sidewalk widths.

Previous Comments:

- 2. Transportation does not support this waiver.
- 3. Menaul and Louisiana are Principal Arterials within a center and require a 10' sidewalks with 6' 8' landscape buffers. San Pedro and Uptown are Major Collectors within a center and require 10' sidewalks with 5'-6' landscape buffers. Based on the justification letter it appears the existing sidewalks are 5' in width, which is narrower than allowed for any City streets other than local streets. This is a high intensity land use area and there is adequate space for the applicant to comply with the required widths.
