Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 11-111-2021, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

## Access Road and Auxiliary Access Road: 1.

- Proposed sidewalk on northern portion of site will need to be labeled as SIDEWALK DETAIL not RAMP DETAIL. Please adjust text.
- A Condition of Final C.O. Approval for Dions:
  - 1. Work Order CPN 670982 be built/constructed and approved by COA.
  - Dutch Bros Coffee built, approved and Final CO approved
- Motorcycle parking spaces: Please reference sign face detail B5/TCL-2 instead of 2. proposed text 2/TCL.
- Proposed ADA parking stall aisle ramp (C5/TCL-2) is not acceptable. Please provide an 3. alternate design and remove proposed shown on sheets TCL-1 & TCL-2.
- ADA parking stall signs need to be referenced (detail: C5/TCL-2) on sheet TCL-1 4.
- Per DPM, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the ADA 5. parking stall access aisles to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details. Prior comment not addressed (according to detail C4 & D5 of sheet TCL-2 details).
- Provide a copy of refuse approval. Comment not addressed 6.
- All one-way drives shall have "One Way" and "Do Not Enter" SIGNAGE and 7. pavement markings. Please show detail and location of posted signs and striping.Comment not addressed. Need to provide Do Not Enter signs (both sides of exit lane) at end of drive thru lane. Another concerns below that were not addressed:
  - Payment marking details need to be provided (prior comment).
  - 'Do Not Enter' sign face detail will need to be provided (prior comment).
