Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 2-6-17 the above referenced plan is not approved to be included in the SWPPP, to apply for an ESC Permit for grading and Building Permit or to be included in the Work Order construction plans until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. The plan does not have a legend for the BMPs.
- 2. Proposed grades on the western, eastern and southern boundaries are higher than existing grades so sediment BMP is required on these boundaries.
