The ADA access aisles shall have the words "NO PARKING" in capital letters, 1 each of which shall be at least one foot high and at least two inches wide, placed at the rear of the parking space so as to be close to where an adjacent vehicle's rear tire would be placed. (66-1-4.1.B NMSA 1978)

2.

Motorcycle parking spaces must be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.

3. One-way vehicular paths require pavement directional signage and a posted "Do Not Enter" sign at the point of egress.

- ADA ramps cannot extend into the access aisles of the accessible parking 4. spots.
- The site plan should indicate that the road around the back of the site is base course and if it will be built in a later phase.
