Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 12-19-13, the referenced Erosion Sediment Control (ESC) Plan is approved for Building Permit.

One clarification is the lack of a BMP Detail for Inlet Protection (IP) on your detail sheet. I did find the SWPPP plan for this site, in our office, and it included an Inlet Protection Detail. We expect these details will be required by the SWPPP inspection team.

A copy of this approved ESC Plan must be included in the Building Permit sets prior to Hydrology sign-off.
