Since half of this site is in the City and the other half is not in the City, comments on the ESC plan will be limited to the portion of the site in the City limits.

- 1. Show the jurisdictional line on the plan.
- 2. Provide inlet protection for the proposed inlet in the northern pond.
- 3. Vehicle Tracking Control is not addressed on the plan.

Albuquerque

The City is providing recommendations for BMPs outside the city limits. Since this portion of the site is outside City limits, these items are not required to be shown on the plan, but may help your client be in compliance.

- 1. Provide inlet protection for the proposed inlet in the southern pond.
- 2. Propose sediment BMP at the eastern edge of the disturbance.
