

## Re: Self-Storage 3601 Seven Bar Loop Rd. NW Conceptual Traffic Circulation Layout for DFT Approval Engineer's Stamp 06-5-24 (B14D019)

Dear Mr. Eberle,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 06-20-24, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

1. The ADA accessible spaces must include a van accessible aisle. Keep detail 6 on sheet TCL-3 and remove detail 5



2. ADA curb ramps must be updated to current standards and have truncated domes installed.

3. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.

4. Traffic Studies: In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic Impact Study. Fill out the updated Traffic Scoping Form (TSF) and email it to Curtis Cherne at <u>CCherne@cabq.gov</u>
