
Re: Drainage Ordinance (14-5-2-1) Violations for Erosion and Sediment Control

Dear Mr. McCarthy

The following violations were observed at the inspection two days ago.

- 1. The east silt fence has a hole near the north end and sediment offsite there and near the southeast corner in the vicinity of the offsite curb and inlets.
- 2. Track-out at the north entrance.



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


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Required Mitigation:

- 1. Initiate maintain of stormwater controls immediately upon identification of the need and complete such work by the end of the next business day.
- 2. Implement additional track-out controls to insure that sediment is removal occurs prior to vehicle exit.
- 3. Where sediment has been tracked-out onto paved areas outside your site remove and dispose of sediment by the end of the same business day.

If the violations are not mitigated within 7 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
