

1. Install BMPS per approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with an additional requirement that if grades remain as they exist today a sediment pond or second layer of sediment control is required in the southwest corner as it an outfall.

2. Bring in a chemical toilet.

a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
