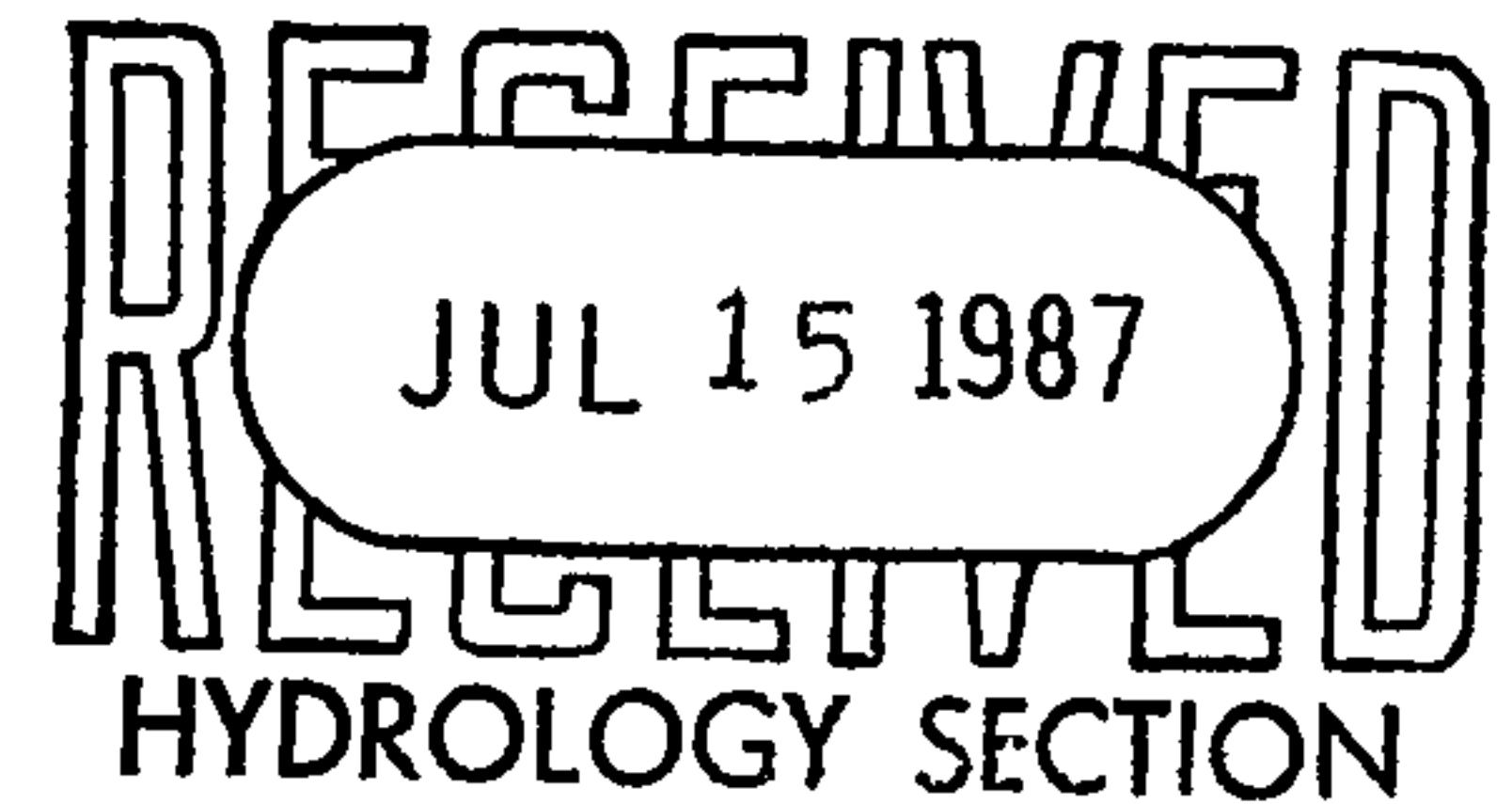

Based on the information provided on your submittal of June 29, 1987,  
listed you will find certain items that will need to be addressed prior  
to final approval:

1. Please provide a typical cross-section of a swale within the dirt area so that the contractor can construct to.
2. How do you propose to get the runoff along the south property line onto the asphalt area?
3. What type of erosion control do you propose during the construction phase?
4. T.B.M. must be established on a permanent location, rebar may be destroyed during the grading process.
