- Clarify 2 additional inlets in NW corner of parking lot.
- Clarify 1 additional inlet on north side of carwash in middle of chamber.
- Clarify 1 additional inlet on south side of building, west end of chamber.
- Clarify 1 additional inlet in SW corner of parking lot.
- Call out curb cuts on southern end of parking lot along Alameda.
- Call out sidewalk and sidewalk culvert on as-built.
- Cut plate on SW culvert flush with sidewalk.
- Paint plate on SW culvert grate with 1 shop coat red oxide, 2 finish coats of aluminum paint (AASHTO M 69).
- Provide safety railing at vertical drop at SW corner of parking lot next to main entrance on Alameda.

All corrections must be as-built on permanent CO submittal. An inspection by our office will need to take place after these corrections are made.
