Albuquerque Based on the Certification received 12/14/18, the Engineer's Certification **is not** approved for ROFG/SIA for Hydrology. The following comments need to be addressed for approval of the above referenced project:

- The inlet near the corner of Oakland and San Pedro needs to be constructed. It was discussed back in May 2018 that this inlet is to be constructed with Legacy Apartments Phase II. However, this inlet is not on their Infrastructure List so the financial guarantee for the inlet is solely on Legacy Apartments Phase I.

Once this inlet is built and approved by the City, the request for FOFG can be resubmitted. At that time no fee will be assessed for the resubmittal.
