Re: Drainage Ordinance (14-5-2-1) Violations for Erosion and Sediment Control

Dear Mr. Solomon,

1. SWPPP self-inspection reports have not been submitted.

SWPPP self-inspections and accompanying reports are required once every 14 days and within 24 hours after a precipitation event of 0.25 inch or greater.

Required mitigation:

1. Perform self-inspections and document conditions on an inspection report(s) and provide the report(s) to the City.

Self-inspection reports can be hand-delivered, e-mailed or kept on-site. If kept on-site, the location is to be communicated to the City and the location must be accessible to the City during regular work hours.

If the violations are not mitigated within 7 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Ordinance.
