This letter is to acknowledge the comments given to us by Nilo Salgado, Ernie Gomez and Jeanne Wolfenbarger of the Transportation Department regarding the accessible path requirement between Stone Age Climbing Gym and Tin Can Alley. We are proposing a new ramp to be installed by means of two compliant handrails at a location adjacent to the Stone Age handicap parking stalls at a location which complies with slope requirement in all directions. Furthermore, we propose to provide a temporary barricade adjacent to the Stone Age handicap spaces that will direct disabled patrons to the Stone Age entrance only. This barricade would be removed once the permanent handrails are installed.
