Required mitigation:

Albuquerque

- 1. Provide a sediment BMP on all lots. Sediment BMP can be silt fence or a cutback behind the curb.
- 2. Remove sediment from the street.
- 3. Remove concrete wash-out.
- 4. Provide an acceptable concrete wash-out at the site when pouring concrete or applying stucco.

Per the previous Violation letter, the City is assessing a fine of \$5000. This fine is for ten days.
