At today's inspection the following violations were observed:

- 1. The inlet protection in Signal Ave required maintenance
- 2. There was too much loose dirt on the south side of Signal without a sediment BMP. This much sediment would overwhelm the inlet protection.
- 3. Contractors were exiting the site onto Wilshire Ave. and there is no track-out pad.



Required mitigation:

1. Perform maintenance on inlet protection.

2. Provide sediment BMP for loose dirt in Signal ave. or remove loose dirt including the dirt pile.

3. Install track-out pad for exiting onto Wilshire Ave. or inform contractors not to exit onto Wilshire Ave.

If violations are not mitigated within 30 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
