

Required mitigation:

- 1. Replace the wire enclosures with leak-proof refuse containers
- 2. Properly contain and dispose of all Construction and domestic wastes.
- 3. Provide self-inspection reports. The most recent received is dated 5/24/2019.

Self-inspection reports can be hand-delivered, e-mailed or kept on-site. If kept on-site, the location is to be communicated to the City and the location must be accessible to the City during regular work hours.

If the violations are not mitigated within 7 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
