Dear Mr. Likar,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 9-6-12, the above referenced plan can not be approved for Grading Permit or Building Permit until the following comments are addressed

- The plans must be stamped, signed and dated by a PE.
- Show existing contours surrounding the site.
- Additional elevations should be given on sidewalks.
- Standard flow and volume calculations per the DPM are required.
- Provide a table showing existing flows and developed flows.
- Show the elevations at the dumpster sites and the inlet tying into the SAS system.
- Show a section of the retaining walls. A max height of 8' can not be exceeded unless a variance is obtained. Also if retaining more than 18" a designed drawing must be provided.
