Dear Mr. Walla,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 11-19-2012, the above referenced grading plan is not approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- Please quantify the flows entering the property from the south. Include these flows in your runoff calculations.
- Note #5 should be eliminated from the plan and the plate for the sidewalk culvert should extend to the curb. Add notes to extend the culvert 2 feet back from the property line to the south and to tack weld the bolts. Standard SO-19 literature should appear on the plan set.
- Identify the benchmark designation.
- Will a stem wall be required on the northwestern portion of the building? If so, details should be provided.
- We suggest that the southern roof drain be directed west and north through the landscape area rather than drain to the parking area as shown.
- Please depress the northern landscape area as it appears it is too steep as it enters the invert of the culvert as well as to assist in water harvesting.
