On March 30th, you were informed of the following required mitigation:

- 1. Silt fence wasn't buried.
- 2. There was a gap at the outfall location. The site drains to this location.

At today's inspection, the silt fence wasn't buried at the outfall location and dirt was piled against the fence sporadically and was not buried. There is a difference between burying the silt fence and piling dirt against it. See detail on approved plan.

If violations are not mitigated within 30 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
