- 1. WHAT IS THE STATUS FOR PARKING REQUIREMENTS? PLEADSE ELABORATE: Need to listed the number of parking spaces required by the IDO as well as the proposed number of parking spaces including bicycle and motorcycle parking. Coordinate/discuss with Zoning (IF APPLICABLE).
- 2. Maximum access width for arterial, collector, and **local streets(<u>JACS LANE</u>**) are as follows:

One-way Drive	20'-25'	12'-20'	
Two-Lane Drive	22'-30'	22'-24'

- 6. Fire Department: An approved Fire 1 plan needs to be provided.
- 7. It is not apparent what type of pavement surface is being proposed. A hard driving surface will be required as part of this proposed project for drive aisles. Please provide the pavement design to substantiate the required pavement surface.

## Other Notes

- 8. Shared Site access: driveways that straddle property lines, or are entirely on one propertybut are to be used by another property, shall have an access easement. Please include a copy of your shared access agreement (Reciprocal Easement DOC#2008003763) with the adjacent property owner.
- 9. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing (2430 & 2415A).
- 10. Please provide a letter of response for all comments given.
- 11. Traffic Studies: See the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) thresholds. In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic Impact Study. Visit with Traffic Engineer for determination, and fill out a TIS Form that states whether one is warranted. In some cases, a trip generation may be requested for determination (Contact Matt Grush: <a href="mailto:mgrush@cabq.gov">mgrush@cabq.gov</a>).
