Dear Mr. Baker,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 06-25-2020, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. Please coordinate all calculations for parking spaces, including bicycle and motor cycle parking with Zoning and list the number required.
- 2. Please list the aisle widths. Some dimensions are not shown.
- 3. The minimum drive aisle width for two way traffic is 22ft, for Fire lane is 20 ft width.
- 4. The minimum parking stall dimensions are:

- 5. The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of signs.
- 6. Motorcycle parking spaces: Label pavement MC.
- 7. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines (**Provide notes on site plan**):
  - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
  - The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places.
     Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.

- c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
- d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
- e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
- f. Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 8. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 9. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 10. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.
- 11. List radii for all curves shown; for passenger vehicles. Radius for **delivery trucks**, **fire trucks**, etc. is **25 ft**. or **larger**.
- 12. Per the IDO, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances. Please clearly <u>dimension this 6</u> <u>ft</u> pathway. The parking stall overhang cannot impact the clear 6ft ADA pedestrian pathway.
- 13. Per DPM, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the ADA parking stall access aisles to the building entrances. Otherwords, the ramp opening will need to be 6 ft in width per this
- 14. Refuse vehicle maneuvering shall be contained on-site. The refuse vehicle shall not back into the public right of way.; provide a copy of refuse approval. Verify this is the case.
- 15. The clear sight triangle will need to begin at back of curb and gutter.
- 16. Provide a detail of entrance driveway because the proposed drivepad/driveway is very confusing drivepad. Why are constructing a 6 ft valley gutter where the ADA pedestrian pathway across driveway should be? This is very confusing, please address this concern.
- 17. Please specify the City Standard Drawing Number when applicable.
- 18. Shared Site acces: driveways that straddle property lines, or are entirely on one propertybut are to be used by another property, shall have an access easement. Please include a copy of your shared access agreement with the adjacent property owner. This applies to 6 ft landscape buffer, and existing 36 inch wall from adjacent property.

- 19. Provide notes showing what work is included and on the work order and the private work on site.
- Work within the public right of way requires a work order with DRC approved plans.

21. Please add a note on the plan stating "All improvements located in the Right of Way must be included on the work order."
