Dear Mr. Lengyel,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 07-26-2021, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

 Listed are the number of parking spaces required by the IDO as well as the proposed number of parking spaces including bicycle and motorcycle parking.
 Coordinate/discuss with Zoning.

2. Provide turning template exhibit for your delivery vehicles shown on site plan for ingress/egress movements at entrance.

3. Identify all existing access easements and rights of way width dimensions (IF APPLICABLE).

4. Provide all street names for proposed development. Some names are no shown on site plan.

5. Provide notes on site development infrastructure for proposed versus existing.

6. Identify the <u>right of way width</u>, medians, curb cuts, and street widths on Las Lomitas and Cuesta Abajo Ct.

7. The minimum parking stall dimensions are:

Type of parking	Min. Width	Min. Length	Min. Overhang
Standard	8.5'	18'	2'
Compact	7.5'	15'	1.5'
Motorcycle	4'	8'	N/A
ADA	8.5'	18'	2'

- 8. Label the compact parking spaces by placing the words "COMPACT" on the pavement of each space.
- 9. ADA curb ramps must be updated to current standards and have truncated domes installed at the corner of Las Lomitas/Cuesta Abajo at the entrance off Cuesta Abajo.

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- 10. Motorcycle parking space: Label pavement MC.
- 11. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines:
 - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
 - b. The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places. Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
 - c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
 - d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
 - e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
 - f. Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 12. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 13. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 14. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.
- 15. Show all drive aisle widths and radii. Some dimensions are not shown.

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16. The minimum drive aisle dimensions are shown below

	Minimum Drive Aisle Width	
Two Way Traffic	22'	
Main Circulation Road	24'	
Fire Lane	20'	

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17. List radii for all curves shown; for passenger vehicles. Radius for delivery trucks, fire trucks, etc. is 25 ft. or larger.

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- 18. Per the IDO, a <u>6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances</u>. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.
- 19. **Las Lomitas Drive Sidewalk**: A certain northern portion of sidewalk is missing. Coordinate with agency on the railroad tracks to complete the sidewalk connection.
- 20. Provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 21. It is not apparent what type of pavement surface is being proposed. A hard driving surface will be required as part of this proposed project for parking area and drive aisles. Provide design for truck/delivery route.
- 22. Please provide a sight distance (Intersection) exhibit line at the corner of Las Lomitas/Cuesta Abajo.
- 23. Please specify the City Standard Drawing Number when applicable.
- 24. Shared Site access: driveways that straddle property lines, or are entirely on one propertybut are to be used by another property, shall have an access easement. **Please**

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include a copy of your shared access agreement with the adjacent property owner.

- 25. AGIS shows this existing property with more than one lot line. Was there a Re-PLAT? If not, please provide an approved PLAT this is development.
- 26. Provide notes showing what work is included and on the work order and the private work on site.
- 27. Work within the public right of way requires a work order with DRC approved plans.
- 28. Please add a note on the plan stating "All improvements located in the Right of Way must be included on the work order."
- 29. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
- 30. Please provide a letter of response for all comments given.
- 31. Traffic Studies: See the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) thresholds. In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic Impact Study. Visit with Traffic Engineer for determination, and fill out a TIS Form that states whether one is warranted. In some cases, a trip generation may be requested for determination (Contact Matt Grush: mgrush@cabq.gov).
