Re: Drainage Ordinance (14-5-2-1) Violations for Erosion and Sediment Control

The following violations were observed at Monday's inspection.

- 1. Stormwater controls (BMPs) were supposed to have been installed prior to beginning construction but they are still missing, specifically the ponds and the silt fence are missing.
- 2. Self-inspection reports were requested 4/2/20 and have not been provided.
- 3. Sediment has been tracked onto the adjacent paved street and sidewalks.

4. Tracked out sediment has not been cleaned up the same day that it occurs. Photos are shown below.





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Required Mitigation:

- 1. Install and maintain BMP's.
- 2. Provide a copy of the latest self-inspection report and conduct inspections in accordance with the city ordinance § 14-5-2-11(C)(1).
- 3. Implement additional track-out controls as necessary to ensure that sediment removal occurs prior to vehicle exit per CGP 2.2.4.c.
- 4. Where sediment has been tracked-out from your site onto paved roads and sidewalks, remove the deposited sediment by the end of the same business day in which the track-out occurs per CGP 2.2.4.d.

If the violations are not mitigated within 7 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
