Based upon the information provided in the Certification received 05-15-13, the above referenced Certification is <u>not acceptable</u> for release of a Permanent Certificate of Occupancy by Hydrology. The following comments need to be addressed before a CO is given for phase 3.

- 1. Include certification language and seal on sheets CG.1 and CG.2
- 2. The berm along Derickson Ave does not appear to be compacted to the specified 90% compaction.
- 3. There is a low spot at the construction entrance allowing flows to enter Derickson Ave. instead of flowing to the inlet at the NW pond. There is also a high spot just to the west of the entrance.
