Required mitigation:

- 1. Provide sediment BMPS on lots. For lots under construction a sediment pond (cutback) behind the curb may be the best solution. Silt fence, filter sock or a cutback behind the curb are acceptable BMPs for lots.
 - 2. Remove sediment from street(s).

If the violations are not mitigated within 30 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.
