The SWPPP incorrectly says Tiera West is the inspector, but reports are by E2RC. <b>Required Mitigation:</b> The SWPPP, including the SWPPP Map, Self Inspection Reports, and Corrective Action Reports, must be kept up-to-date per CGP 7.1 and available on-site per						
	CGP 4.7.3. 5.4						
2	<b>BMPs</b> need to be maintained per CGP 2.1. The trackout pad was full of sediment and needed reset.						
	Required mitigation: If at any time you find that a stormwater control needs routine Maintenance, you
