Dear Mr. Stern,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 08-02-2019, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- List the number of parking spaces required by the zoning code as well as the proposed number of parking spaces including bicycle and motorcycle parking.
- 2. Please show the the ADA access space. The dimension is not shown.
- The ADA sign is not shown: The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of signs.
- 4. The ADA access aisles shall have the words "NO PARKING" in capital letters, each of which shall be at least one foot high and at least two inches wide, placed at the rear of the parking space so as to be close to where an adjacent vehicle's rear tire would be placed. (66-1-4.1.B NMSA 1978)
- 5. Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.
- 6. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines:
 - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
 - The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places.
 Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
 - c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
 - d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
 - e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
 - Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.

- 7. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 8. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 9. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.
- 10. A 5 ft. keyway is required for dead-end parking aisles.
- 11. Per the IDO, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.
- 12. Per DPM, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the ADA parking stall access aisles to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.
- 13. ADA accessible pedestrian pathway should not be placed behind parking space or adjacent to a vehicular way. Vehicle and pedestrian/wheel chair conflicts should be avoided as much as possible.
- 14. Refuse vehicle maneuvering shall be contained on-site. The refuse vehicle shall not back into the public right of way.; provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 15. All one-way drives shall have "One Way" and "Do Not Enter" signage and pavement markings. Please show detail and location of posted signs and striping.
