- 2. Provide additional narrative that discusses the improvements "around" the Starbucks".

- 3. Proposed spot elevations should be shown for work done on this plan only, unless you wish to certify the grades outside the Starbucks pad in which case it is OK.
- 4. Provide a build note for the channel through the landscape area.
- 5. Provide a curb cut at/near the 5138.80 spot elevation to allow water from the drive aisle south of the building to flow into the stormwater quality pond southwest of the building. A channel to the pond bottom would help prevent erosion down the side of the stormwater quality pond.
- 6. Some curbing along the southerly property line must be removed. Provide permission or modification for the removal of the curbs.
- 7. Provide details for the trash enclosure to ensure runoff will remain within the enclosure. Included a note that the drain must be connected to a Grease Trap then to the sewer system. Show the location of the Grease Trap and the inverts for the pipe.

Sorry Cutis, I got your voicemail earlier but had to run to several meetings right after. The basin size for the Starbucks is the same as was shown on the approved G&D as Basin #11 for the whole site. I have marked the basin boundary on the attached. The improvements on the downstream side within the LMG project are in progress. They are probably a couple of weeks out from completing the curbs around the building and 2 or 3 weeks out from starting to pave the parking lot.

They have not yet submitted plans for building permit but they wanted to install the retaining wall on the Starbucks pad with the work they are doing out there now. Call me if you have any questions.

Good afternoon.


I called you earlier today about the g and d have a similar question on the ESC plan.
