Based upon the information provided in your submittal dated 12-9-11, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Platting action by the DRB until the following comments are addressed:

- This plan proposes grading on adjacent property to the south and has graded on adjacent property to the east to make it work. Provide written approval from adjacent property owners.
- Per our conversation 12-14-11, the intent is to construct the retaining wall between the pads at the time the houses are built. Add a note that the retaining walls are to be built by the home builder.
- The Grading Plan is to be certified and in substantial compliance prior to Building Permits being approved.
