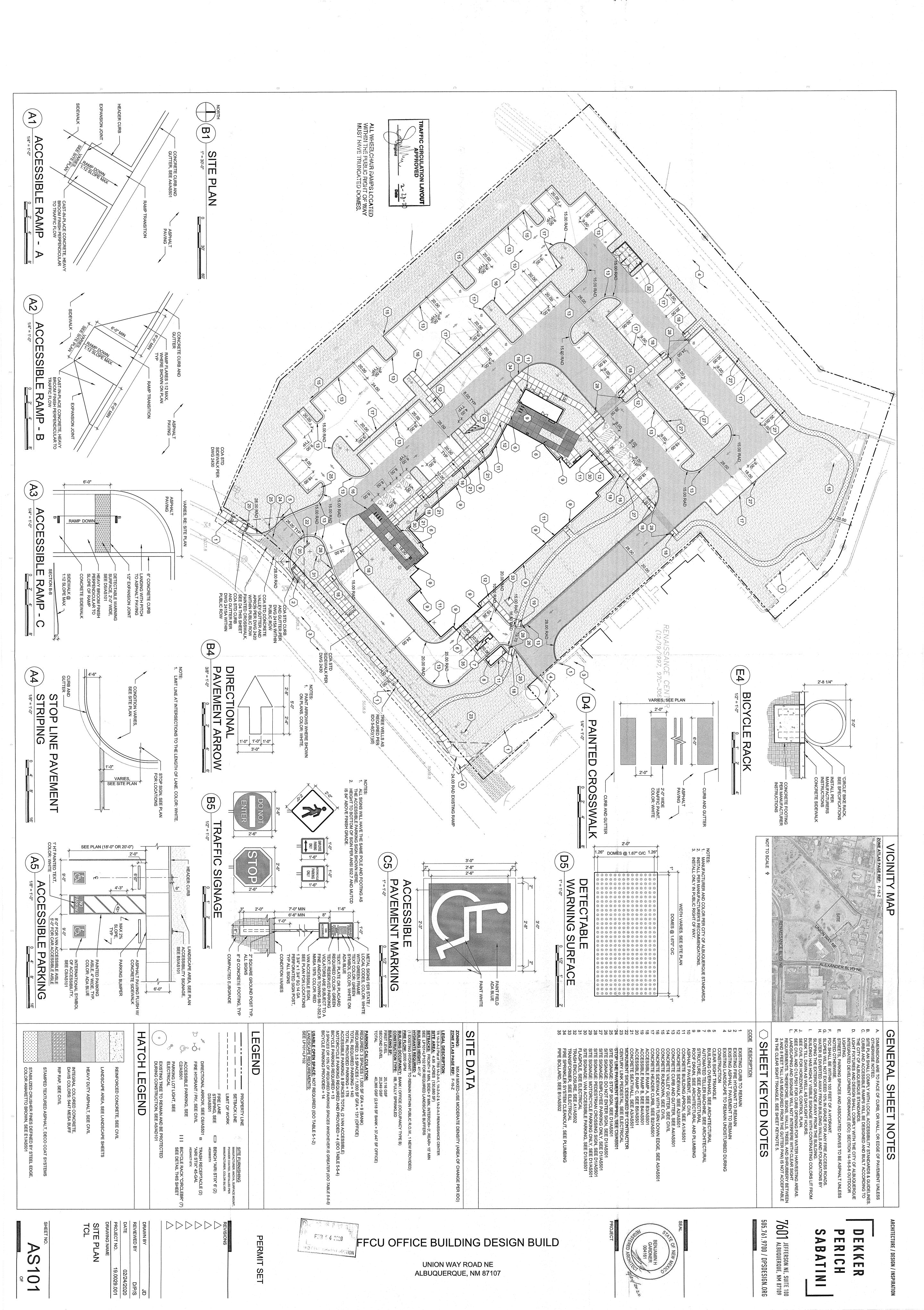

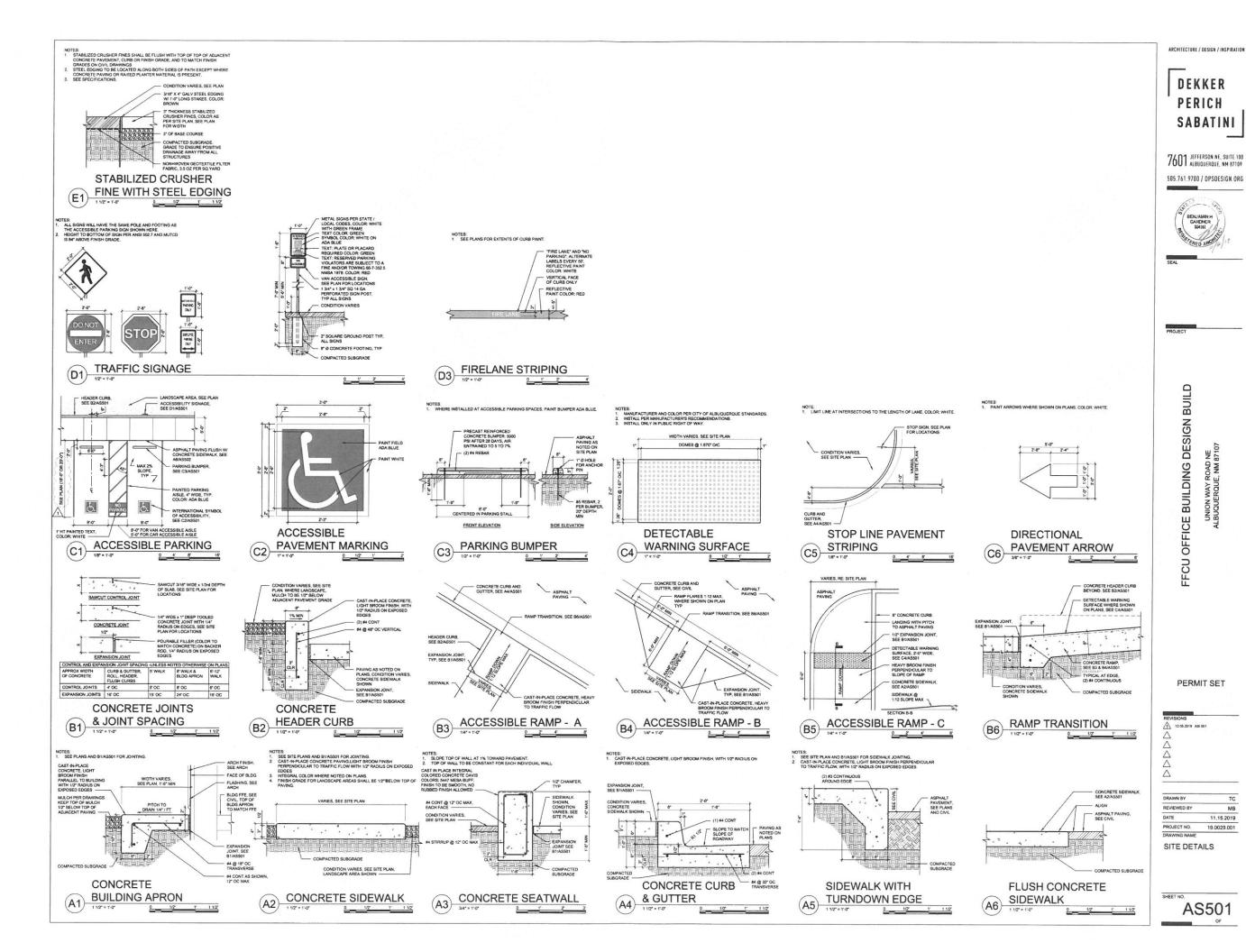

We have a new First Financial Credit Union building located in the Renaissance Center (see attached KMZ). We are punching in a new driveway along Union Way for use by the site as well as some other routine utility connections within the ROW. Can we detail out the driveway returns on our Building Permit set? Or how would you like that completed?
