



Wes/Jon,

I was out at the above referenced site yesterday for an inspection. The following issues were observed:

- 1. There was track-out onto McLeod Rd at the west entrance/exit.
- 2. There was no sediment BMP at the upstream end of the culverts that go under I-125. Please install sediment BMP per approved plan, unless all the work is complete in this area, and remove sediment from upstream of the culverts.
- 3. The inlet in the I-25 frontage Road had debris on the grate and the inlet protection needs maintenance/be put back. Please remove debris from the grate and reinstall the inlet protection.
- 4. There was too much sediment in McLeod Rd between the inlet and the I25 frontage Rd. Please remove sediment from this area and prevent this from occurring in the future.

Standard mitigation time is seven days.




