Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 07-31-18, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

PO Box 1293

- 1. Please review and revise plan to provide all information listed on the Traffic Circulation Layout checklist.
- 2. Please refer to the Accessible Parking Checklist and revise the plan accordingly.

Albuquerque

- Please refer to IDO regarding bicycle parking.
- 4. New access entrance off Restaurant Lane NE, please revise to 28 foot in width.
- Please correct Motorcycle parking for Hotel under Site Data.

NM 87103

- 6. Please identify all existing buildings, doors, structures, sidewalks, curbs, drive pads, wall and anything that influences the parking and circulation on the site.
- 7. Identify all existing access easements and rights of way width dimensions.

- 8. Please list the width and length for all existing and proposed parking spaces. Some dimensions are not shown.
- 9. Van accessible aisles should be 8ft wide; all others should be 5ft wide.
- 10. The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of HC signs.
- 11. Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.
- 12. Per the IDO, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.
- 13. Design delivery vehicle route needs to be shown.

- 14. Service vehicle and/or refuse vehicle maneuvering must be contained on-site; provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 15. It is not apparent what type of pavement surface is being proposed. A hard driving surface will be required as part of this proposed project for parking area and drive aisles.
- 16. Show the clear sight triangle and add the following note to the plan: "Landscaping and signage will not interfere with clear sight requirements. Therefore, signs, walls, trees, and shrubbery between 3 and 8 feet tall (as measured from the gutter pan) will not be acceptable in the clear sight triangle."
- 17. Please specify the City Standard Drawing Number when applicable.
- 18. Please include a copy of your shared access agreement with the adjacent property owner.
- 19. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
- 20. Please include one copy of the traffic circulation layout at the next submittal.

Resubmit a revised plan along with fully completed Drainage Transportation Information Sheet to front counter personnel for log in and evaluation by Transportation.
