Dear Mr. Soule,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 03-29-12, the above referenced plan is approved for Building and Grading Permit. If one acre or more is being disturbed this project requires a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharge. If $\frac{3}{4}$ acre or more is being disturbed Topsoil Disturbance Permit will be required.

Albuquerque's MS4 Permit became effective March 1st, 2012. Grading and Drainage Plans and Drainage Reports will have to comply with the requirements of the new permit. The permit is available online at www.cabq.gov/Planning/landcoord/Hydrology.html
